Thank you for your application for a Used Oil & Material Processing Permit Renewal for the above referenced Facility. A Department staff review of the application submitted on February 22, 2022, indicates the application is incomplete. Pursuant to the provisions of Rule 62-710.800(3), Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.) and Chapter 403.722, Florida Statutes (F.S.), all processing of the application is suspended when a permit application is deemed incomplete. Please provide the information listed below and refer to this correspondence in your response.

1. Item B. 1. Of the Solid Waste Application Form: A description of the operation of the facility including (Rule reference 62-701.710(2)(a)):
 - a. The types of materials, i.e., wastes, recyclable materials or recovered materials, to be managed or processed;
 - b. The expected daily average and maximum weights or volumes of materials to be managed or processed;
 - c. How the materials will be managed or processed;
 - d. How the materials will flow through the facility including locations of the loading, unloading, sorting, processing and storage areas;
 - e. The types of equipment that will be used;
 - f. The maximum time materials will be stored at the facility;
 - g. The maximum amounts of wastes, recyclable materials, and recovered materials

- that will be stored at the facility at any one time; and
- h. The expected disposition of materials after leaving the facility.
2. Item B.9 of the Solid Waste Application Form: History and description of any enforcement actions related to solid waste management facilities in Florida owned by the applicant (Rule reference 62-701.710(2) and 62-701.320(7)(i).
 3. Used Oil Processing Facility Permit Application, A. General Information, Item 1 and 2, Page 1 of 9: Please insert the current permit expiration date and revision number.
 4. Used Oil Processing Facility Permit Application, A. General Information, Item 14, Page 2 of 9: Please provide the of name of Professional Engineer, registration number, telephone number, email, mailing address, etc.,
 5. Used Oil Processing Permit Application, C. Operating Information, Item 1, and Page 3 of 9: Please correct the Hazardous Waste Generator Statue, from “CESQG” to “VSQG”.
 6. Attachment 1: A brief description of the facility operations: CBI, Inc. Fort Pierce Facility is registered with FDEP as a Used Oil transfer facility and has two (2) tanks not 1) tank. Please correct this discrepancy.
 7. C.B.I. Inc. Port Everglades Facility Tank Farm – Revised Site Plan Map, needs to be update based on Table #1 Vertical Tanks. Storage Tanks 12 to 16 are installed in 2013 and they are not Proposed Vertical Storage Tanks anymore. Please review and revise as appropriate.
 8. Please provide C.B.I. Inc. Port Everglades Facility Tank Farm – Revised Site Plan Map with 8.5”X11” in Word document, so that the map can be easily inserted into the renewal draft permit.
 9. Please provide a tank table with all the information (Refer the Existing Permit, Page 30) with 8.5”X11” in Word document, so that this can be easily inserted into the renewal draft permit.
 10. Any additional comments from the Southeast District Office, we will forward to you ASAP.

In order for the Department to continue processing your application, please submit the information requested as soon as possible, and refer to this correspondence in your response. The response must be signed, sealed, and dated by a registered Florida Professional Engineer. The Department must receive a response within 30 days of the date of this letter, or April 7, 2022 unless a written request for additional time to provide the requested information is submitted and approved. Pursuant to subsection 62-730.220(6), F.A.C. and Section 120.60, F.S., failure of an applicant to provide the timely requested information by the applicable deadline may result in
