Dear Mr. Powell,

The Environmental Quality Division (EQD) has reviewed a Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) hazardous waste inspection report for your facility, **USEPA ID# FLR000233361**. The FDEP determined that your facility was operating as a **Very Small Quantity Generator (VSQG)**.

City of Jacksonville Ordinance Code Section 123.102 establishes a Hazardous Waste Annual Verification Fee for hazardous waste generators in Duval County. The Hazardous Waste Annual Verification Fee for a VSQG is \$305.00.

Facilities subject to this fee typically receive invoices during January of each year. However, the fee is based on the City of Jacksonville's fiscal year of October 1 through September 30. Any facility generating hazardous waste for any portion of the fiscal year is responsible for full payment of the fee.
