Thank you for your application for a Used Oil Processing Permit Renewal for the above referenced Facility. A Department staff review of the application submitted on December 20, 2022, indicates the application is incomplete. Pursuant to the provisions of Rule 62-710.800, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.) and Chapter 403.722, Florida Statutes (F.S.), all processing of the application is suspended when a permit application is deemed incomplete. Very Small Quantity Generator (VSQG)". Please review the 8700-12FL form and the Permit Application and make modifications as appropriate to ensure that the two (2) forms are consistent.
- 2. Used Oil Processing Facility Permit Application, Part I. C. Operating Information, Item number 2. List Applicable EPA Hazardous Waste Codes, Page 3 of 8: Permit application lists "D001", however, Form 8700-12FL, Florida Notification of Regulated Waste Activity, Item Number 10, Waste Codes for Federally Regulated Hazardous Wastes, lists D001, D002, D008, D009, F001, and F002. Please review the

8700-12FL form and the Permit Application and make modifications as appropriate to ensure that the two (2) forms are consistent.

- 3. Spill Prevention Control and Countermeasures Plan (SPCC) And Contingency Plan and Emergency Procedures, Section 1, Evaluation and Testing, Page 2: In accordance with Chapter 62-762, periodic internal and external inspections of the tanks are required to assess the condition of the above ground tanks and determine their suitability for continued service. Please provide copies of the most recent inspections for all tanks listed in the application and clarify the frequency of all inspections.

The Department must receive a response within 90 days of the date of this letter, or April 20, 2023, unless a written request for additional time to provide the requested information is submitted and approved. Pursuant to subsection 62-4.055(1), F.A.C., failure of an applicant to provide the timely requested information by the applicable deadline may result in denial of the application.
