Thank you for your application for a Used Oil and Material Processing Permit Renewal for the above referenced Facility. A Department staff review of the application submitted on February 28, 2023, indicates the application is incomplete. Pursuant to the provisions of Rule 62-710.800, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.) and Chapter 403.722, Florida Statutes (F.S.), all processing of the application is suspended when a permit application is deemed incomplete. Please provide the information listed below and refer to this correspondence in your response.

- 1. Used Oil Processing Facility Permit Application, Part II Certification, P.E., Signature Date and Seal is Incomplete, Page 9 of 9: Please review this page and revise as appropriate and resubmit.
- 2. Spill Prevention Control and Countermeasures Plan (SPCC) And Contingency Plan and Emergency Procedures, Section 1, Evaluation and Testing, Page 2: Tanks shall be evaluated, and the re-testing frequency shall be established and implemented in accordance with API Std 653, November 2014, incorporated by reference in subsection 62-762.411(3), F.A.C. Storage tanks shall be evaluated at the time of installation. Evaluations shall be certified by a professional engineer licensed in the State of Florida or approved by an API Std 653 certified inspector. Non-destructive testing shall be performed by qualified personnel as specified in API Std 650, March 2013, incorporated by reference in subsection 62-672.201(67), F.A.C. and API Std, November 2014. All field erected tanks shall be repaired in accordance with API Std

- 653, November 2014. Field erected tanks with storage capacities of less than 250,000 gallons may be evaluated in accordance with STI SP001, January 2018, incorporated by reference in subsection 62-782.411(3), F.A.C., in lieu of API Std 653, November 2014. Internal and External inspections of the tanks may be required, to assess the condition of the above ground tanks and determine its suitability for continued service. Therefore, provide copies of the most recent internal and external tank inspections for all tanks listed in the application.
- 3. Used Oil and Material Processing Permit Applications, C. Operating Information, Items, three (3) through eight (8), Attachments are not labeled and not paginated: Please review all attachments and revise as appropriate and resubmit.
- 4. Please provide Facility Site Plan (8.5"X11") and Tank Table (8.5"X11") in word documents in order for us to insert them into the renewal permit.
- 5. Please provide a brief history and description of any environmental enforcement actions taken by the Department, delegated local program, or federal agency against the applicant and provide a history of any reported releases or spills by the applicant within the past five (5) years.
- 6. General Comment: Please review the entire permit application and update as appropriate.

In order for the Department to continue processing your Permit Application and deem it complete, please submit the information requested as soon as possible, and refer to this correspondence in your response. The response must be signed, sealed, and dated by a registered Florida Professional Engineer. The Department must receive a response within 30 days of the date of this letter, or April 14, 2023, unless a written request for additional time to provide the requested information is submitted and approved. Pursuant to subsection 62-4.055(1), F.A.C., failure of an applicant to provide the timely requested information by the applicable deadline may result in denial of the application.
