To Whom It May Concern

I am the Chief Financial Officer of Florida Power and Light Company ("FPL") located at 700 Universe Blvd., Juno Beach, Florida 33408. This letter is in support of the use of the provision of Chapter 62-710.600(2)(e), Florida Administrative Code, to provide evidence of self-insurance by FPL, as the Used Oil Transporter and as a business entity registered in the state of Florida. This self-insurance is in lieu of vehicle insurance in the amount specified. Self-insurance is applied to vehicle insurance in the amount of a minimum of \$1,000,000 including pollution coverage for sudden and accidental alleged or threatened discharge, dispersal, seepage, migration, release or escape of used oil and any cost or expense related to pollution damage for which FPL as the transporter is legally liable.

I hereby certify that FPL has the resources necessary to comply with the self-insurance limits set in Chapter 62-710.600(2)(e), Florida Administrative Code.
