On February 15, 2012, representatives of the Department conducted an inspection at the property located at 109 Applewood Dr, Longwood, Seminole County, Florida (Site). The site is operated by Sunburst Trees & Lawn Care, Inc. The property on which the site is located is owned by Robert H Madsen & John J. Barr.

Sunburst Trees & Lawn Care, Inc. (Sunburst Trees) is a Florida corporation. The President and Registered Agent is Edward R. Cooley and the officer is Manuel Tata, who is also the manager of the site. Sunburst Trees is a tree service and lawn care operation. Sunburst Trees does not have a Department permit for the diposal or processing of solid waste or a registration for a source separated organics procession facility.

Property Description

The site is located at 109 Applewood Dr, Longwood, Seminole County. It is located in Longwood in a mixed industrial area, Section 29, Township 20 South, Range 30 East; Latitude 28o 43' 0" and Longitude 81o 21' 31", Seminole County, Florida 32750. More specifically the property is described as:

LEG LOT 15 BAYWOOD INDUSTRIAL PARK PB 20 PG 10


Inspection:

The property was inspected in conjuction with Longwood Code Enforcement. Stockpiled yard trash was visible from the gate of a fenced in storage area. Allison Price, the site representative, did not allow access to the storage area. It appeared that the material was brought in from other locations. There was no evidence of on-site land clearing activites.

During a subsequent phone conversation with Manny Tato on 2/16/2012, he stated that Sunburst trees had been bringing the yard trash from job sites and temporarily storing the material on the property before taking it Seminole County Central Transfer Station. He was told that this requires a registration for a yard trash transfer station. He said that he will remove the existing material from the property.
