## Good Afternoon Mr. Snedegar,

This email serves as a follow up to the used oil transporter compliance evaluation inspection conducted on August 22, 2023, by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP). We appreciate your taking the time to escort us through the inspection of Speedy Oil Environmental LLC (SOE), located 6940C Mission Lane, Fort Myers, Florida. As discussed during the inspection, SOE is required to submit the following documentation/information to the Department in order to return to compliance:

- 1. Pursuant to Chapter 62-710.500(1&2): Used oil transporters must register annually with the Department using Form 62-730.900(1)(b), "8700-12FL Florida Notification of Regulated Waste Activity". The registration form shall be accompanied by a registration fee of \$100.00 per facility. The SOE facility is currently operating without a current registration. Please provide documentation of notification for 2023 and proof of payment by the given deadline.
- 2. Pursuant to Chapter 62-710.510(1): Each registered person shall maintain records on DEP Form 62-710.901(2), "Used Oil and Used Oil Filter Record Keeping Form and Instructions," or on substantially equivalent forms which contain at least the same information as the Department form. Please provide the Department with records from 2023 which include the following: name, business address, telephone number, and EPA ID of transporter; the source of the used oil, including the name and address of each source; the total number of gallons of used oil received from each source; the type of used oil received; the date of the receipt; the destination or end use of the used oil, including the name and street address of each destination;
- 3. Pursuant to Chapter 62-710.510(5): No later than March 1 of each year, used oil transporters are required to submit an annual report for the preceding calendar year to the Department on DEP Form 62-710.901(3). <u>Please provide the Department with documentation of your 2022 Annual Report by the given deadline</u>.
- 4. <u>Please provide used oil and used oil filter disposal receipts from Universal Environmental Services, Inc. (UES) for 2023.</u>
- 5. SOE utilizes two collection trucks. <u>Please provide the USDOT# for the second collection truck.</u>
- 6. Pursuant to 62-710.600(2)(e): Have, verify, and maintain vehicle insurance with a

combined single limit of no less than \$1,000,000. Provide the Department with proof of insurance for both collection trucks using DEP Form 62-730.900(5)(a) State of Florida Certificate of Liability Insurance for Hazardous Waste Transporters and Used Oil Handlers.

7. It was discussed that Speedy Oil Recovery LLC (EPAID: FLR000180612) is no longer operating; however, it was discussed that used oil filters are being transferred by SOE to the facility location at 5680 Pangola Road, Fort Myers, FL for pick up by UES, and thus the facility is currently operating without a valid registration. In order to return to compliance, the Speedy Oil Recovery facility must register with the Department, or SOE must immediately cease the transfer of used oil filters to Speedy Oil Recovery. <u>Please</u> provide the Department with an explanation of how used oil filters will be managed going forward.
