Dear Kelly Brandenburg:

The purpose of this letter is to provide notice that the permit numbered 76517-009-HO and 76517-010-SO will expire on **April 14, 2024**. Prior to sixty (60) calendar days before the expiration of this permit, a timely and sufficient application for the renewal of the permit shall be submitted on forms¹ and in a manner prescribed by the Department and as stated in your permit. Please ensure that your DEP Form 8700-12FL is current, as this information is reviewed during the permit renewal process.

Your application should voluntarily provide a brief history and description of any environmental enforcement actions taken by the Department, delegated local program, or federal agency against the applicant and provide a history of any reported releases or spills by the applicant within the past five years. Although a specific format is not required, your brief history and description should contain the following information: State, delegated local or federal program (e.g., EPA, FDEP Hazardous Waste, NPDES, Department of Air Resources, etc.), date and type of enforcement action, if any (e.g., Warning Letter, Notice of Violation, etc.); a brief description of release or spills; a brief description of assessment and cleanup process (e.g., De Minimis Cleanup, Interim Source Removal per rule 62-780.525, F.A.C., etc.); administrative Consent Order (CO) number and date if CO if issued; and date and type of resolution if resolved (e.g., approval of the Interim Source Removal Report, return to Compliance letter, etc.).

A timely and sufficient application and processing fee are due by **February 12, 2024** (60 days prior to expiration), in accordance with Rule 62-4.090, F.A.C. If the renewal application is submitted at a later date, it will not be considered timely and sufficient unless it is submitted and made complete prior to the expiration of the permit. When the application for renewal is timely and sufficient, the existing permit shall remain in effect until the renewal application has been finally acted upon by the Department.

The application shall meet the fee requirements of Rule 62-4.050 and Subsection 62-710.800(4), F.A.C. The used oil operating permit renewal fee is \$2000 and the solid waste operating permit renewal fee is \$1000 for a total of \$3000 for a complete application. The Permittee shall submit a copy of the cover letter accompanying the permit application and the fee to:

If the Permittee intends to submit the renewal fee electronically, the Permittee must contact the Department's RCRA Manager referenced below to obtain instructions no more than 24 hours prior to the payment of the fee.
