# Introduction:

January Environmental Services (January) was inspected on December 9, 2022, to determine the facility's compliance with used oil transporter and transfer facility rules and to document closure activities. The facility was originally notified as a small quantity generator on March 25, 1988, under the name Ashland Chemical Company. In 2004, January submitted notification as a Used Oil Transporter, Transfer Facility, Marketer and Filter Transporter. The Department has conducted numerous Hazardous Waste inspections of this facility, most recently on April 12, 2022. Neil Lakhlani, Director/Brooker, GeoTech Environmental Inc.; Chris Sappington, VP of Operations, Global Environmental and Industrial Response, LLC (Global); and Tom Putman, Manager, Global; accompanied the inspectors during the inspection.

# **Process Description:**

January was a used oil, used oil filter and oily waste transporter and storage facility and a wastewater transporter. The facility is located on a 5.18-acre property that was purchased by January Transport, Inc., on October 20, 2004. The facility consisted of a 5,414 square foot building which houses offices, a laboratory and warehouse; a used oil tank farm; and a rail spur. Prior to closure, the facility had one part-time administrative employee, one driver working from this location, and was open from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday. The City of Bartow provided sewer and potable water services.

# RECENT COMPLIANCE/PERMIT/ENFORCEMENT HISTORY

• December 17, 2017: January's most recent used oil processor permit (307171-HO-004) was issued; this permit expired on December 7, 2022. While the facility had not processed used oil since 2017, the permit was required to allow the facility to store used oil on site for more than 35 days. January was required to submit the permit renewal application to the Department by no later than February 16, 2022, 60 days prior to the permit expiration date.

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- December 9, 2021: The Department issued a permit renewal reminder letter.
- March 25, 2022: Division requests an inspection of January based on the permit renewal not being submitted.
- April 12, 2022: Compliance Evaluation Inspection documented the following violations:

- The Permit renewal paperwork was not submitted at least 60 days prior to the permit expiration date as required by Rule 62-710.800(4), F.A.C.

- The Annual Used Oil Transporter/Transfer Facility registration had not been timely submitted as required by Rule 62-710.500(1), F.A.C. and Rule 62-710.500(2), F.A.C.

- The Annual Used Oil Filter Transporter/Transfer Facility registration had not been timely submitted as required by Rule 62-710.850(3), F.A.C.

- The Annual Report by Used Oil and Used Filter Handlers had not been timely submitted as required by Rule 62-710.510(5), F.A.C.

- Verification of employee training was not available, as required by 62-710.600(2)(c), F.A.C.
- April 11, 2022: Initial Permit Renewal documents were received (Closure Cost Estimate).
- April 15, 2022: The Renewal Application and 60-day Extension Request received.

• April 22, 2022: Warning Letter number WL22-47HW53SWD was issued, and the final April 12, 2022,

Compliance Evaluation Inspection was attached. A response was due by May 11, 2022.

• April 26, 2022: The First Request for Additional Information for the Permit Application letter was issued by the Department. Response due by June 25, 2022.

• May 12, 2022: Warning Letter reminder email sent to January requesting that a meeting be scheduled; response due not later than May 16, 2022.

- May 27, 2022: January submits the Driver Training Records.
- May 31, 2022: The Department sends potential Warning Letter meeting dates to January.

• June 1, 2022: The Department issues the Annual Florida Used Oil/Used Oil Filter Transporter, Used Oil/Used Oil Filter Transfer Facility, and Used Oil Processor Registration Letter to January; the registration year runs from June 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023.

- June 2, 2022: The Department issues an email setting a Teams Meeting for June 23, 2022.
- June 23, 2022: Enforcement Meeting held. Either a Short Form Consent Order (if the permit renewal is quickly completed) or a Long Form Consent Order will be issued.
- June 27, 2022: Additional Permit Renewal documents submitted to the Department.
- July 21, 2022: The Second Request for Additional Information for the Permit Application letter was issued by the Department. Response due by September 19, 2022.
- September 14, 2022: Permit Renewal Teams Meeting held.

• September 16, 2022: January's consultant requests a 30-day extension to submit revised Permit Renewal documents.

• September 21, 2022: The Department grants the extension to submit revised Permit Renewal documents until October 21, 2022.

• On October 20, 2022: The Department received notice via email that January does not intend to renew their Used Oil Processing Facility permit.

• November 16, 2022: The Department issues an email stating that due to the permit not being renewed, the Facility is now subject to the facility Closure Conditions of Permit 307171-004-HO/307171-005-SO:

- The owner or operator shall notify the Department in writing at least 60 days prior to the scheduled date of closing the facility and

- Within 30 days after closing the facility, the owner or operator shall submit a certification of closure completion to the Department which demonstrates that the facility was closed in substantial compliance with the detailed closure plan.

• December 1, 2022: The Department received notice via email that January is in the process of selling the property to Global Environmental and Industrial Response, LLC. The Department agrees to conduct an inspection of the facility on December 9, 2022, to verify the current condition of the facility.

• December 7, 2022: The Department sent an email stating that proper closure under Permit 307171-004-HO /307171-005-SO would need to be completed and that the prospective purchaser would need to apply for a new permit once they obtained control of the property.

Previously, the facility picked up waste products (wastewater, used oil and used oil filters) from its customers. Used oil was collected from customers in the facility's used oil truck or the two tanker trailers and was pumped into the used oil aboveground storage tanks (ASTs) using the overhead used oil loading rack adjacent to the railroad spur. Used oil brought back to the facility in smaller containers was also pumped into the used oil ASTs. The two used oil tanker trailers were also used to transport the used oil to used oil processing facilities. January did not accept used oil or oily water from other transporters nor collect public used oil. Used oil filters that were brought back to the facility in smaller containers were consolidated into large metal bins and stored on-site prior to transportation for final treatment and disposal. The facility was under contract with Aqua Clean Environmental Company (EPA ID #FLR000193466) to transport wastewater; wastewater was not brought back to the facility but transported directly to Aqua Clean Environmental Company for processing. All collection operations had ceased prior to the inspection.

### Laboratory

No wastes were present in the on-site laboratory.

### Waste Storage Inside the Warehouse Building

All waste had been removed from the Warehouse building. See attached photos.

### Used Oil Process Tanks

The two process tanks that were part of the former used oil processing plant were confirmed to be empty.

### Registered Aboveground Storage Tanks

The final load of flowable used oil had been removed from the six white 24,000-gallon aboveground used oil storage tanks (ASTs) on the morning of the inspection. A receipt for the final 6,500 gallons, removed on the morning of December 9, 2022, was provided via email on December 12, 2022, and is attached; this load was transported to the January facility in the January Recycling Facility located at 4300 SW 36th Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. The manways near the bottom of the tanks were open to allow for the inspection; residual oily sludge was still present in the bottom of each tank (see attached photos). The containment around the tank farm was in good condition, did not contain any free liquids, and appeared to be adequate to contain the volume of the tanks. These ASTs are registered with the Department's Storage Tank Program, facility ID # 53/ 9101026. Based on discussions with Global, these tanks will be reused by Global moving forward.

### Other Storage Tanks Located Outside

A green AST has been installed in a separate containment area attached to the existing containment; at the time of the inspection this tank was empty. A second green AST and one silver ASTs were observed laying on their sides in the yard west of the tank farm; all three were empty.

### Vehicles

None of the vehicles previously used by January were present at the time of the inspection.

• February 3, 2023: Proposed Long Form Consent Order #23-0013 was re-issued to January to correct a small typo.

- February 3, 2023: Signed Long Form Consent Order #23-0013 was received by the Department.
- February 7, 2023: Long Form Consent Order #23-0013 was executed and sent to January.
- February 7, 2023: Closure Plan approved by the Department.
- March 6, 2023: Facility Closure Report received by the Department.

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- March 13, 2023: Long Form Consent Order #23-0013 penalty payment made through the Department 's web portal.
- March 13, 2023: Closure Report approved by the Department.


