### Good Afternoon,

This email serves as a follow up to the hazardous waste compliance evaluation inspection conducted on <u>August 7<sup>th</sup>, 2024 (08/07/2024)</u> by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP). We appreciate your team for taking the time to conduct the walkthrough of <u>Nathan Todds OCD Cleaning LLC dba FL Emergency Cleaning [FLR000262535]</u> (hereinafter referred to as NTEC or Facility) located at <u>5755 SW Savage St, Palm City, FL 34990</u>. As discussed during the inspection with facility representatives, NTEC is required to submit the following documentation/information to the Department:

- What is the square footage of the facility?
- How many employed staff?
- When did the facility begin operating at this location?
- What are the times of operations?
- Used oil receipts were observed on-site. Provide used oil manifests or receipts from Safety-Kleen for further review.
- Photo of testing tool and provide what types of test it conducts.
  - Waste determinations and test for hazardous waste
  - Halogen testing <1,000 ppm for used oil</li>
- Facility has exceeded the 24hr time limit for transporting used oil. Either confirm that hence further the facility will ensure they meet the 24hr time limit or will renotify as a transfer facility and meet transfer facility regulations.
- Documentation of trainings including Hazwoper for all employees who will manage or handle hazardous waste or used oil.
- Does the facility maintain a contingency plan or a Spill Prevention, Control & Countermeasure (SPCC) Plan? If so, provide it for review.
