Thank you for your visit on February 26. In support of the responses below, I have attached pertinent documentation, all of which I hope sufficiently addresses your request for documentation and responses to your inquiries:

Request: A list of trainings that are conducted for all personnel and the date of the most recent training.

Response: I've provided a spreadsheet detailing EnviroServe's annual trainings for our FDOT drivers, field technicians, and management. Our office staff are exempt from some of the corporate training requirements because they do not work in the processing areas of the facility. I am also providing a list in spreadsheet format that details the annual training that is required by EnviroServe. A working copy of this list is maintained for each team member with the dates each module is completed by that team member. (LMS SPREADSHEET)

Request: A copy of your training certification for RCRA courses or DOT Haz-Mat

Response: Please find attached copies of training certificates for courses and training related to RCRA and FDOT hazardous materials completed by me and other members of our team.

Request: An update on the six drums that were within the drum segregation area and were pending analysis.

Response: Please find attached copies of the profiles and TNI-accredited

laboratory analyses for the material in the segregated drums. Those profiles and associated analytical results confirm these materials to be non-hazardous. (SEE ATTACHMENTS)

During the inspection, there were six 55-gallon drums within the metal Request: filter drum holding area. Please provide an update on these drums and their contents. Response: Please find attached a copy of the non-hazardous waste manifest on which five (5) of these six (6) drums containing metal filters were transported to Shamrock (Aqua Clean). The sixth drum had very little in the way of waste and the items in this drum were transferred to the other drums to consolidate the shipment. All drums contained metal oil filters, which originated from various inbound drums that, on occasion when dumped for processing, are found to contain this type of filter. Obviously, we segregate these metal oil filters from the other materials prior to processing and consolidate the filters for proper offsite shipment and disposal.

I hope this information is sufficient to address the outstanding items from your inspection. Should you have any questions or require anything else, please let me know. Thanks again.
