RE: Non Compliance Letter

Dear Ms. Simmons:

The Department has reviewed the aboveground tank assessment performed by Criner Petroleum and Wellpoint Service, Inc., submitted on 9/22/98.

According to the information provided, North Florida Oil, Inc. is not in compliance with the requirements of Specific Condition # 5 in Section II, Operating Requirements, of the Used Oil Processing Permit #HO06-0027221 concerning the structural integrity and tightness of the process and storage tanks and integral piping.


To continue operations the facility must submit, within fifteen (15) days of receipt of this notice, a detailed schedule of corrective actions which outlines the steps and time frames, for each deficiency noted in the report, that the facility will implement in order to return to compliance.

Listed below are items considered to be deficient and in need of repair:

1. Tank #1 - Piping and valve leaks.
2. Tank #2 - Piping and valve leaks.
3. Tank #5 - Largest tank in poor condition and has broken valve.
4. Tank #6 - Can not check due to missing ladder.
5. Tank #8 - Can not check due to missing ladder.
