Dear Mr. Berg:

We have reviewed the additional information submitted on your behalf by Seaburn and Robertson on December 1, 1986. The following information is required to complete your application and ensure compliance with all current rules.

1. The enclosed new application form must be completed and returned (DER Form 17-7.130(1)).
2. A foundation analysis pursuant to Chapter 17-7.050(2)(b), F.A.C.
3. Complete design drawings (17-7.050(3), F.A.C.). For those items which you feel have been previously submitted and still apply, please indicate the drawing number and submittal date.
4. The liner material and installation plans, etc., will need approval prior to installation, once you decide which material to use.
5. A timetable for methane gas checks on the closed portions of the landfill.
6. Sufficient information and engineering drawings to ensure compliance with Chapter 17-25, F.A.C. We have been advised by SWFWMD that a 40D-4 permit will be required by their office.

7. A Groundwater Monitoring Plan has been issued for the site, however we have not yet received the required well completion reports. This information, along with the initial analysis results, is necessary to evaluate the effectiveness of the Plan and to determine its adequacy, and should include:

Well identification	Driller's log
Latitude/longitude	Total depth of well
Aquifer monitored	Casing diameter
Screen type and slot size	Casing type and length
Screen length	Direction of groundwater
Elevation at top of pipe	flow in screened zone
Elevation at land surface	SWFWMD well construction
Elevation at top and bottom of collection zone	permit numbers
8. The location and number of fire extinguishers, hydrants, and other safety devices.
9. A description of available reserve equipment.
10. The land use agreement between Citrus County and the Department of Agriculture has been extended to January 1, 1988. This is not an adequate time period for the operation of the landfill. The agreement does not recognize the requirements of Section 17-7.075, F.A.C., particularly the need for right of access and 20 year post-closing care. Please provide evidence of agreement between the county and the Department of Agriculture regarding operation and/or closure of the site after January 1, 1988.
11. Financial responsibility must be demonstrated pursuant to 17-7.071, F.A.C.

As discussed at our October 10, 1986, meeting and described in my letter of October 13, 1986, we expect implementation of this proposal by February 1, 1987. Therefore, if these items are not submitted by that date, the application will be denied due to incompleteness.
