

In March of 1995, Hardee County Landfill contracted with Kenetech Resource Recovery, Inc., for the processing of the wood and yard waste. They processed 773.87 tons of wood and yard waste.

There is approximately 1,940.33 tons on site at the present time. Hardee County is working with Kenetech Resource Recovery, Inc., and Wheelabrator Ridge Energy, Inc., at the present time to review the options of off-site processing or on-site processing and then shipping the processed wood to Wheelabrator as a fuel product. A decision on the most effective method should be made in this quarter.
