Dear Mr. Prestridge:

This is to acknowledge receipt of your application to operate a waste tire processing facility at the Hardee County Class I Landfill.

This letter constitutes notice that a permit modification will be required for your project pursuant to Chapter(s) 403, Florida Statutes.

Information submitted for a permit modification is incomplete. Please provide the information listed below promptly. Evaluation of your proposed project will be delayed until all requested information has been received.


The following information is needed in support of the waste tire processing facility application request [Chapter 17-711, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.)]:

1. A site plan sheet on which the following items are annotated:
  - a. Description of waste tire pile or processed tire pile dimensions, not to exceed: (1) width: 50 feet; (2) area: 10,000 square feet; and (3) height: 15 feet (FAC 17-711.540(2)(b)).
  - b. Assurance of 50 foot wide fire lane placed around the perimeter of each tire pile (FAC 17-711.540(2)(c)).
2. Please complete items 2, 3, 5(a), and 5(d) through 5(g) on the enclosed waste tire checklist.
3. Provide a description of the processing equipment and the processing capacity of the equipment.
4. Provide a closure plan describing compliance with each of the items in 17-711.700(3).

5. Any questions concerning proof of financial responsibility pursuant to Rule 17-711.510(2), FAC, should be directed to Mr. Bill Parker and Mr. Fred Wick in Tallahassee at (904) 922-6104.
6. Provide documentation, pursuant to Rule 17-711.510(4), that you have "executed a bona fine contract with a waste tire processing facility or a mobile tire chopper, cutter, or shredder which assures that all waste tires on the site will be processed every three months".
7. Recent conversations indicate you may want to pursue a waste tire collection center general permit, rather than a waste tire processing facility permit. However, your submittal indicates that you plan to store more than 1,000 waste tires at one time. For your facility to qualify for the general permit, you must provide confirmation that no more than 1,000 waste tires are stored outdoors at any one time, pursuant to FAC 17-711.801(1)(a). Should you desire a waste tire collection center general permit instead of a waste tire processing facility permit, please complete the enclosed General Permit Application, DER Form 17-711.900(2), as well as Items 1. and 2. of this incompleteness letter.
8. If you cannot confirm Item 7. above, then you will need to obtain a permit modification for a waste tire processing facility, and must comply with each of the items in 17-711.530, FAC. Enclosed is a copy of the waste tire rule for your use.

As this request serves as a summary of all remaining items needed to complete this submittal, we will expect to receive the requested information within the next 30 days. If you cannot provide this information within 30 days, please contact us and arrange an appropriate schedule thru which the information can be provided. If we cannot reach a satisfactory agreement concerning timely submittal of this information, the Department will be placed in the position of denying this request for a permit modification. Therefore, if there are points which must be discussed and resolved, please contact me at (813) 623-5561, extension 399 to arrange a meeting.
