Requirements

G.P. application will be withdrawn

Notes: Michael Vardeman asked if he could operate while permit was pending. JK says no. -(They do not qualify for a G.P.) Application fee is 1250⁰⁰
Rinker believes tires are a Raw material. J.K. says Burning Tires are specifically covered in Rule 17-711
J.L. says Notice Requirements will take at least 28 days.
4 Trailers/day @ 1400 tires per trailer x 3 day supply on site
(16,000 tires)

Financial Responsibility @ \$100/tire commonly Performance bond
Agreements/Conclusions Reached:

- If they go out of tire business then bond will be returned
- Permit application & check will be submitted - signed & sealed by P.E. including attachments. No tires will be placed on ground. Emergency operations manual & Fire safety survey are required per J.K.

Facility means where tires are stored in trailers connected through processing. SB. will they be subject to enforcement if they operate when NOI is issued. JK will find out.

J.L. suggests modifying his permit to include SW Requirements
