The following explanation is given in response to Manatee County's October 27, 1994 and March 1, 1995 letters regarding the existing leachate pond:

The existing leachate pond is located within the confines of the existing Stage I slurry wall and is not subject to the requirements of F.A.C. Rule 62-701.400(6).

This pond was constructed as part of the slurry wall liner system approved by Permit No. SC41-67529 issued July 29, 1984. Construction for the Stage I liner system was completed prior to January 1, 1992 and is exempt from all current liner and impoundment design criteria.
