SUBJECT: Meeting with Ogden Martin & Malcolm Pirnie  
concerning proposed waste-to-energy plant

Jeff Kowal of Ogden Martin Systems (OMS) met with the Department on August 13th to introduce himself as Resident Construction Manager and to inform us of the schedule for facility construction. Don Markley of Malcolm Pirnie accompanied Mr. Kowal. Mr. Markley was hired by Lee County to oversee work performed by OMS.

Mr. Kowal indicated that Peter Young of OMS is the project manager with over all responsibility of the project. His phone number is 201/882-7246 and address is P.O. Box 2615, 40 Lane Road, Fairfield, New Jersey 07007.

The project received approval form the Governor's office on June 15 and Mr. Kowal said that the documents of 12/9/91, containing specific conditions relating to this Department still apply. I told him that we didn't have a copy of these documents and would try to obtain the latest version from Buck Oven's office in Tallahassee.

OMS will submit a stormwater plan to SFWMD and copy DER. The project coordinator in SFWMD is Susan Coughanour 407/686-8800 ext. 6920. OMS will also submit a dewatering plan to SFWMD for construction of the refuse pit. This water will be directed to a detention pond located N.W. of the facility.

OMS will make notification if they come across any artifacts or endangered species during the course of construction. OMS will report to DER 15 days prior to construction commencement and submit quarterly progress reports thereafter.
