Dear Mr. Mounir:

A compliance inspection was conducted at the above referenced facility on April 01, 2013, under the authority of Section 403.091, Florida Statutes (F.S.). During this compliance inspection, possible violations of Chapter 403, F.S., Chapter 62-701, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), and Chapter 62-711, F.A.C. were observed. The purpose of this letter is to offer you compliance assistance as a means of resolving these matters.

Please see the attached inspection report for a full account of Department observations and be advised this Compliance Assistance Offer is part of an agency investigation preliminary to agency action in accordance with Section 120.57(5), F.S. We request you review the items of concern noted in the attached inspection report and respond in writing (or by e-mail) within **15 days** of receipt of this Compliance Assistance Offer. Your written response should either:

1. Describe what you have done to resolve the issue (see "Recommendations for Corrective Action" section of the report),
2. Provide information that either mitigates the concerns or demonstrates them to be invalid, or
3. Arrange for one of our inspectors to visit your facility to offer suggested actions to return to compliance without enforcement.

It is the Department's desire that you are able to document compliance or corrective actions concerning the possible violations identified in the attached inspection report so that this matter can be closed without enforcement. Your failure to respond promptly in writing (or by e-mail) may result in the initiation of formal enforcement proceedings.

Corrective Action: A "Waste Tire Processing Facility" permit is required if storage will be greater than 1500 waste tires at any given time.

Rule: 62-701.300(1)(a)

Explanation: During the inspection, waste tires in excess of the 1500 waste limit were stored at the site.

Corrective Action: The operator/owner must apply for a "Waste Tire Processing Facility" permit if storage will be greater than 1500 waste tires at any given time.

This facility submitted a permit application on October 22, 2012 to the Department of Environmental Protection-Central District, for a waste tire processing permit. The DEP-Central District issued a "Permit Application No. WT 48-0314658-001 Complete" letter on January 17, 2013. However, at the time that the "Complete" letter was issued by DEP-Central District, the financial assurance mechanism was not submitted for approval to DEP Solid Waste Financial Assurance -Tallahassee.

At the time of the inspection, the financial assurance requirement was not met. The inspectors discussed the lack of financial assurance with Mr. Aziz Mounir and the necessity of acquiring the financial assurance mechanism. Mr. Mounir told the inspectors that he applied to an insurance company for the financial assurance mechanism and is working toward getting this mechanism.

On April 26, 2013 the Department issued the Solid Waste Operation Permit for this facility (Permit No.: 0314658-001-WT-02). The permit states the following condition regarding the financial assurance under section 2.G.1: "A cost estimate was approved on January 17, 2013 for the closing cost of \$30,000. The funding of this cost estimate will allow for up to 20,000 tires to be stored at the facility at any one time. Until the cost estimate is funded per section 2.G.2 below, the maximum amount of tires allowed to be stored on-site at any one time is 1,500 tires."

On May 3, 2013 Carolin Heaviside contacted Mr. Mounir to determine if the financial assurance mechanism was acquired. Mr. Mounir told Carolin Heaviside that he did not acquire the financial assurance and that Rayan Tire Wholesale Inc. was sold.

A review of the Florida Department of State Division of Corporations database provided confirmation that the ownership of Rayan Tire Wholesale, Inc. had been transferred on February 22, 2013. The name of the current registered agent and director is Rene Ahwal.

Since the facility has been sold and is now under new ownership the permit must be transferred to the new owner and/or responsible party. The enclosed Form 62-701.900(8) must be completed by both Mr. Mounir and Rene Ahwal. The completed form must be submitted to the Department for processing within 15 days of receipt of this report and Compliance Assistance Offer letter.
