The following actions are required before these sites can be deleted from the Sites List:

1. Agricola #1 Sulfuric Acid Plant: "Groundwater Lead" Although available information reveals that the facility has closed down and withdrawn its air permit, documentation is required to show that no contamination exists. The Groundwater Section ORT should be requested to conduct an investigation to obtain the necessary laboratory data to determine if delisting is appropriate.
2. Calloway's Sons, Drum Service: "District Lead" - Site has confirmed groundwater contamination. Since enforcement has been initiated to correct the problems, this effort should be finalized. Once documentation is provided showing that no environmental contamination or public health threat exists or that any residual contaminants are contained, the site can be delisted.
3. Gulf Coast Lead Corporation: "District Lead" - Site is under an EPA CO and cannot be delisted until documentation is provided that the CO terms are fulfilled and concluded.
4. Lena Road LF: "District Lead" - The Groundwater Section ORT report of February, 1985 shows groundwater contamination. Also, the site is under a CO and cannot be delisted until documentation is provided that the CO terms are fulfilled and concluded.
5. Martin Pit (Bobby): "Local Lead" - The site cannot be delisted until all court orders have been fulfilled and concluded and documentation is provided showing that no environmental contamination or public health threat exists or that any residual contaminants are contained.

6. Martin Pit (Charles): "District Lead" - The site cannot be delisted until all court orders have been fulfilled and concluded and documentation is provided showing that no environmental contamination or public health threat exists or that any residual contaminants are contained.
