Jim,

Bob conveyed your message to me yesterday, but I'm a little unsure about the logistics of how I should submit.

I corrected the rule reference error on Engineering Report Page 9, and have attached tracked and untracked copies of the revised page. Should I sign/seal these pages and submit hardcopies, or is the electronic version sufficient?

The Notice of Application was published in Saturday's (Feb. 4<sup>th</sup>) Orlando Sentinel. Our notarized affidavit was mailed out yesterday. So, I expect to receive proof of publication today. We'll scan and email this to you when we receive it, then submit the original via mail (or courier).

I conveyed to John Cook that FDEP will include a couple (few) permit conditions that require WMIF to notify FDEP prior to waste acceptance (60 or 90 day lead time), update and fund financial assurance, update the Operation Plan, and that FDEP may revise and update the MPIS. WMIF does not object to these conditions.

estimates. In accordance with Specific Condition 45 of permits SC48-0165969-001 and SO48-0165969-002, WMIF will provide proof of funding of the financial assurance instrument, in the amount of Department-approved estimates, at least 60 days prior to the initial receipt of waste.

- (j) An operation plan, which includes a contingency plan, is provided in Appendix D of this permit renewal application.

## 9. GENERAL CRITERIA FOR LANDFILLS

### (Rule 62-701.340, Form 62-701.900(1) – Part G)

- (1) Performance Standards – The permitted Class III landfill is designed to control movement of waste constituents such that water quality standards and criteria, and air quality standards will not be violated.
- (2) Minimum Groundwater Criteria – The KRS Class III landfill does not have a bottom liner, therefore the provisions of Rule 62-701.340(2), FAC do not apply.
- (3) Classification of Landfills – The KRS is a Class III Landfill, as defined by Rules 62-701.200(14) and 62-701.340(3)(c), FAC. WMIF does not propose to change this status.
- (4) Location Requirements – The underlying geology is adequate to support the proposed footprint and overburdening waste.

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The permitted landfill is not located within a 100-year floodplain. Maps verifying this are currently on file with the Department for the currently permitted facility.

As shown on Drawing 4 in Appendix B, 50-foot minimum waste setback from the property boundary has been permitted adjacent to areas where deflection liner is to be installed. Please note that most of the deflection liner has already been installed and certified to the Department. The deflection liner has been permitted, as shown on

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
