SUBJECT: Buttrey Expansion Application Review

I have reviewed the referenced document and following are my comments:

1. The Water Table Estimates & Proposed Base Grade Elevations report does not incorporate any mounding impact of the proposed Lake Cora Lee wetland treatment system (to the east of BD4) and the proposed rapid infiltration basins (south of BD4). These proposed projects are within 0-100 feet of BD4 and must be taken into account before permitting of the landfill. Submit a map showing the projected surficial ground water aquifer contours with the proposed Lake Cora Lee and RIBs impacts. The map should be the same scale as Figure 4, Base Grade Elevations BD4 Parcel, so that they may be compared.

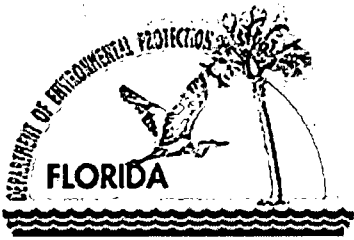

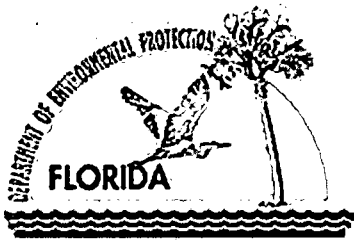



Dear Mr. Buttrey:

Under Section 403.815 of the Florida Statutes and Rule 62-701.320(8)(a) of the Florida Administrative Code, you (the applicant) are required to publish at your own expense the enclosed Notice of Application. The notice must be published one time only within 14 days of receipt of this letter, or if your application is not yet complete, within 14 days of submittal of a complete application. The notice must be published in the legal ad section of a newspaper of general circulation in the area affected. For the purpose of this rule, "publication in a newspaper of general circulation in the area affected" means publication in a newspaper meeting the requirements of section 50.011 and 50.031 of the Florida Statutes in the county where the activity is to take place.
