
The purpose of this letter is to request a change of date for our scheduled meeting, as we discussed yesterday, regarding the two wells in question within 500 feet of the Cerny Road C & D Debris Disposal Facility.

The meeting was originally scheduled for July 21, 2004, at 10:00 am. Can this meeting be rescheduled to August 10, 2004 at 10:00 am. The reason for rescheduling is to allow us time to negotiate settlements with the well owners to disconnect their private potable wells and provide them with public water supply.

At this newly scheduled meeting, we would provide you with the agreements and possibly the validation of the disconnect for the well at 3500 Milford Road. It would then take an additional 2-4 weeks to complete the ECUA public water supply installation and validate the disconnect from the private well at 3509 Nandina Drive.

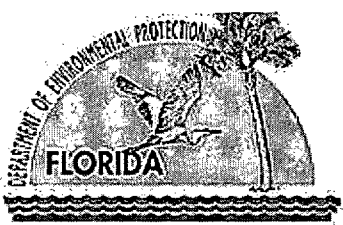
