RE: Hazardous waste transported and received by CSR Rinker (CSR) from Waldron's Petroleum Tank Services (WPTS), 2511 S.W. Second Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, Florida on April 24, 1998.

Dear Mr. Marple:

On May 27, 1998 the Department sent a letter to CSR requesting 11 55-gallon drums not to be treated until after further review. This request was made due to analytical results received by the Department from WPTS on April 29, 1998. WPTS had informed the Department that "Gunk" was being utilized during cleaning operation of tanker trucks which may subject the waste to being listed hazardous waste as referenced in Title 40 Code of Federal Regulation Part 261.31.

Based on the Material Safety Data Sheet provided to the Department this material does not contain any constituents that would subject the waste to being listed hazardous waste.
