This report is submitted in accordance with specific condition #30 of Florida Department of Environmental Protection Permit No. SO48-0026601-001, Bay Lake Landfill. During the third quarter of 2006, the net quantities of Class III Solid Waste, consisting of construction/demolition debris, rubble and yard waste, that were placed in the Bay Lake Landfill are presented in the table below. Please note that the listed quantity of Class III solid waste listed for the month of July is a negative number because the amount of waste that was transferred out of Bay Lake Landfill to another Class III landfill by a third party contractor exceeded the amount of Class III solid waste received.
