Hi John,

I hope you are well this morning. I know you and I already spoke over the telephone regarding some of the items below, but I just wanted to follow up with you in writing.

Although the Class III Landfill permit has a March 1st annual due date for financial assurance documents, the Conditions of Certification has a September 1st annual due date for financial assurance documents related to the Class I Landfill areas of the site. It is fine with me for you to submit financial assurance documents for the entire site (Class I and III Landfill areas) all by September 1st.

Based on Rule 62-701.510(8)(b), Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), the technical report (which includes the water quality monitoring plan and other evaluations) must be submitted every two and one half years. The last report we have on file was submitted in March 2013. The next report is due by September 30th, 2015 (this year).

I have received the Q1 2015 Waste Tire report and the Q4 2014 and Q1 2015 Leachate Generation Reports. If Joanne already finished the Q1 2015 waste quantity report, please submit it and in the meantime I will look into what she said about waste quantity report submittals only being required on an annual basis.

I hope you are well. It was good meeting you earlier this year at the Pasco County Resource Recovery Facility and West Pasco Landfill.

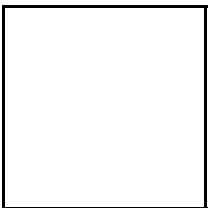
When you have a moment, I am missing the following reports:

- (1.) Water quality monitoring plan evaluation due March 31, 2015 I believe someone else does this. . . .
- (2.) Q1 2015 Waste tire report I am sitting here working on this right now – yes, it is late –
- (3.) Q1 2015 Waste quantity reports I have just finished this, and was debating whether to bother sending it this quarter (which I usually do) because they are only required annually since 2010. Last quarter when I submitted it, I got an email from DEP reminding me that they are only due annually.
- (4.) Revised cost estimates and proof of funding for Class III (Due March 1 for Class III, but not due until September for Class I). **This must be a mistake!** I have no awareness of Class III changing to due as of March 1st. As a matter of fact, I have the approval letter from last year which states that it is due as of September 1st as usual.

When we revised the monitoring plan to delete the leachate monitoring pursuant to the rule change, we also changed the Water Quality Monitoring Plan Evaluation/Technical Report submittal schedule pursuant to the rule change. The Water Quality Monitoring Plan Evaluation/Technical Report is now due every 2.5 years instead of every two years. Recall that the FDEP did not want to change the COC but approved the revisions the monitoring plan. See attached letter.

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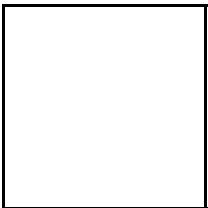

Post-Certification Compliance Review

On April 28, 2014, the Department received a post-certification submittal entitled "Water Quality Monitoring Plan, West Pasco Class I Landfill, April 2014" from CDM Smith, Inc. pursuant to Section XIV, Condition C.3 of the Conditions of Certification. Pursuant to Power Plant Siting Act Rule 62-17.191, Florida Administrative Code, within 90 days after complete information is submitted for post-certification review, the Department shall give written notification to the Licensee of its assessment of whether there is reasonable assurance of compliance with the Conditions of Certification. The Solid Waste Section of the Department has reviewed your submittal and determined that there is sufficient reasonable assurance of compliance with the Conditions of Certification.

Project Location


The activities reviewed under this post certification submittal occur at the West Pasco Class I Landfill located at the Pasco County Resource Recovery Facility in Sections 25 and 26, Township 24 South, Range 17 East at latitude 28°22'22" and longitude 82°34'06".

Project Description

The project was the revision of the Water Quality Monitoring Plan for the West Pasco Class I Landfill by deleting the leachate sampling requirements and changing the time interval for submittal of the WQMP Technical Report.
