Attached is **Permit 129318-004-WT/05**, issued pursuant to Section(s) 403.087(1), Florida Statutes. This letter and its attachments constitute a **complete permit**, and **replace** all previous permits and permit modifications for the above referenced facility.

The Department's proposed agency action shall become final unless a timely petition for an administrative hearing is filed under Sections 120.569 and 120.57, Florida Statutes (F.S.), before the deadline for filing a petition. The procedures for petitioning for a hearing are set forth below.

A person whose substantial interests are affected by the Department's proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrative proceeding (hearing) under Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S. The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed (received) in the Office of General Counsel of the Department at 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Mail Station 35, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3000.

Petitions by the applicant or any of the parties listed below must be filed within 14 days of receipt of this written notice. Petitions filed by other persons must be filed within 14 days of publication of the notice or receipt of the written notice, whichever occurs first. Under Section 120.60(3), F.S., however, any person who asked the Department for notice of agency action may file a petition within fourteen days of receipt of such notice, regardless of the date of publication. The petitioner shall mail a copy of the petition to

the applicant at the address indicated above at the time of filing. The failure of any person to file a petition within the appropriate time period shall constitute a waiver of that person's right to request an administrative determination (hearing) under Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S., or to intervene in this proceeding and participate as a party to it. Any subsequent intervention (in a proceeding initiated by another party) will be only at the discretion of the presiding officer upon the filing of a motion in compliance with Rule 28-106.205, F.A.C.

A petition that disputes the material facts on which the Department's action is based must contain the following information:

- (a) The name, address, and telephone number of each petitioner, the applicant's name and address, the Department File Number and the county in which the project is proposed;
- (b) A statement of how and when each petitioner received notice of the Department's action or proposed action;
- (c) A statement of how each petitioner's substantial interests are or will be affected by the Department's action or proposed action;
- (d) A statement of all material facts disputed by petitioner or a statement that there are no disputed facts;
- (e) A statement of the ultimate facts alleged, including a statement of the specific facts, which the petitioner contends, warrant reversal or modification of the Department's action or proposed action;
- (f) A statement of the specific rules or statutes the petitioner contends require reversal or modification of the Department's action or proposed action; and
- (g) A statement of the relief sought by the petitioner, stating precisely the action the petitioner wants the Department to take with respect to the Department's action or proposed action.

A petition that does not dispute the material facts on which the Department's action is based shall state that no such facts are in dispute and otherwise shall contain the same information as set forth above, as required by Rule 28-106.301, F.A.C.

Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filing of a petition means that the Department's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this notice. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision of the Department have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding, in accordance with the requirements set forth above.

In accordance with Section 120.573, F.S., the Department advises that mediation is not available in this case under the provisions of



that statute. This does not prevent any interested parties from agreeing to other forms of alternate dispute resolution.

Any party to this order has the right to seek judicial review of it under Section 120.68, F.S., by filing a notice of appeal under Rule 9.110, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure, with the clerk of the Department in the Office of General Counsel, Mail Station 35, 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3000, and by filing a copy of the notice of appeal accompanied by the applicable filing fees with the appropriate district court of appeal. The notice of appeal must be filed within thirty days after this order is filed with the clerk of the Department.

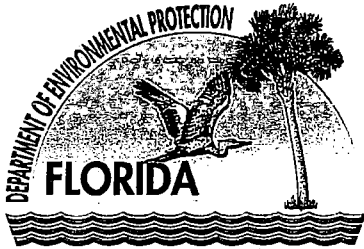

This permit is issued under the provisions of Chapter 403, Florida Statutes, and Florida Administrative Code Rule(s) 62-4, 62-701, and 62-711. The above named permittee is hereby authorized to perform the work or operate the facility shown on the application and approved drawing(s), plans and other documents, attached hereto or referenced in Specific Condition #A.2. and made a part hereof and specifically described as follows:

To operate a waste tire collection facility located at the **Hardee County waste tire collection center**, located on Airport Road, near the City of Wauchula, Hardee County, Florida. The specific conditions attached are for the operation of:

1. Waste Tire Collection Center

General Information: This facility accepts tires from the general public for temporary storage prior to being transferred to a processing facility for recycling, reuse or disposal. Maximum storage capacity for this facility is no more than 1500 tires.

Replaces Permit No.: 129318-003-WT/05

This permit contains compliance items summarized in Attachment 1 that shall be complied with and submitted to the Department by the dates noted. If the compliance dates are not met and submittals are not received by the Department on the dates noted, enforcement action may be initiated to assure compliance with the conditions of this permit..

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

1. The terms, conditions, requirements, limitations and restrictions set forth in this permit, are "permit conditions" and are binding and enforceable pursuant to Sections 403.141, 403.161, 403.727, or 403.861, Florida Statutes. The permittee is placed on notice that the Department will review this permit periodically and may initiate enforcement action for any violation of these conditions.
2. This permit is valid only for the specific processes and operations applied for and indicated in the approved drawings or exhibits. Any unauthorized deviation from the approved drawings, exhibits, specifications, or conditions of this permit may constitute grounds for revocation and enforcement action by the Department.
3. As provided in subsections 403.087(6) and 403.722(5), F.S., the issuance of this permit does not convey any vested rights or any exclusive privileges. Neither does it authorize any injury to public or private property or any invasion of rights, nor any infringement of federal, State, or local laws or regulations. This permit is not a waiver of or approval of any other Department permit that may be required for other aspects of the total project which are not addressed in this permit.
4. This permit conveys no title to land or water, does not constitute State recognition or acknowledgment of title, and does not constitute authority for the use of submerged lands unless herein provided and the necessary title or leasehold interests have been obtained from the State. Only the Trustees of the Internal Improvement Trust Fund may express State opinion as to title.
5. This permit does not relieve the permittee from liability for harm or injury to human health or welfare, animal, or plant life, or property caused by the construction or operation of this permitted source, or from penalties therefore; nor does it allow the permittee to cause pollution in contravention of Florida Statutes and Department rules, unless specifically authorized by an order from the Department.
6. The permittee shall properly operate and maintain the facility and systems of treatment and control (and related appurtenances) that are installed and used by the permittee to achieve compliance with the conditions of this permit, are required by Department rules. This provision includes the operation of backup or auxiliary facilities or similar systems when necessary to achieve compliance with the conditions of the permit and when required by Department rules.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

7. The permittee, by accepting this permit, specifically agrees to allow authorized Department personnel, upon presentation of credentials or other documents as may be required by law and at reasonable times, access to the premises where the permitted activity is located or conducted to:

- (a) Have access to and copy any records that must be kept under conditions of the permit;
- (b) Inspect the facility, equipment, practices, or operations regulated or required under this permit; and
- (c) Sample or monitor any substances or parameters at any location reasonably necessary to assure compliance with this permit or Department rules.

Reasonable time may depend on the nature of the concern being investigated.

8. If, for any reason, the permittee does not comply with or will be unable to comply with any condition or limitation specified in this permit, the permittee shall immediately provide the Department with the following information:

- (a) A description of and cause of noncompliance; and
- (b) The period of noncompliance, including dates and times; or, if not corrected, the anticipated time the noncompliance is expected to continue, and steps being taken to reduce, eliminate, and prevent recurrence of the noncompliance.

The permittee shall be responsible for any and all damages which may result and may be subject to enforcement action by the Department for penalties or for revocation of this permit.

9. In accepting this permit, the permittee understands and agrees that all records, notes, monitoring data and other information relating to the construction or operation of this permitted source which are submitted to the Department may be used by the Department as evidence in any enforcement case involving the permitted source arising under the Florida Statutes or Department rules, except where such use is prescribed by Sections 403.111 and 403.73, F.S. Such evidence shall only be used to the extent it is consistent with the Florida Rules of Civil Procedure and appropriate evidentiary rules.

10. The permittee agrees to comply with changes in Department rules and Florida Statutes after a reasonable time for compliance; provided, however, the permittee does not waive any other rights granted by Florida Statutes or Department rules.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

11. This permit is transferable only upon Department approval in accordance with Rule 62-4.120 and 62-730.300, Florida Administrative Code, as applicable. The permittee shall be liable for any non-compliance of the permitted activity until the transfer is approved by the Department.

12. This permit or a copy thereof shall be kept at the work site of the permitted activity.

13. This permit also constitutes:

- (a) Determination of Best Available Control Technology (BACT)
- (b) Determination of Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD)
- (c) Certification of compliance with State Water Quality Standards (Section 401, PL 92-500)
- (d) Compliance with New Source Performance Standards

14. The permittee shall comply with the following:

(a) Upon request, the permittee shall furnish all records and plans required under Department rules. During enforcement actions, the retention period for all records will be extended automatically unless otherwise stipulated by the Department.

(b) The permittee shall hold at the facility or other location designated by this permit records of all monitoring information (including all calibration and maintenance records and all original strip chart recordings for continuous monitoring instrumentation) required by the permit, copies of all reports required by this permit, and records of all data used to complete the application for this permit. These materials shall be retained at least three years from the date of the sample, measurement, report, or application unless otherwise specified by Department rule.

(c) Records of monitoring information shall include:

- 1. the date, exact place, and time of sampling or measurements;
- 2. the person responsible for performing the sampling or measurements;
- 3. the dates analyses were performed;
- 4. the person responsible for performing the analyses;
- 5. the analytical techniques or methods used;
- 6. the results of such analyses.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

15. When requested by the Department, the permittee shall within a reasonable time furnish any information required by law which is needed to determine compliance with the permit. If the permittee becomes aware the relevant facts were not submitted or were incorrect in the permit application or in any report to the Department, such facts or information shall be corrected promptly.

SPECIFIC CONDITIONS: PART A -SOLID WASTE FACILITY GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

1. **Facility Designation.** This site shall be classified as a waste tire collection center and shall be operated, maintained and closed in accordance with all applicable requirements of Chapters 62-4, 62-711, and 62-701, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.).

2. **Permit Application Documentation.** This permit is valid for operation of the waste tire collection center in accordance with all applicable requirements of Department rules and the reports, plans and other information submitted by the permittee, as follows:

a. Renewal of Waste Tire Small Processing Facility Permit Application, dated January 23, 2012 (rcvd February 6, 2012), as revised, replaced or amended by information dated March 5, 2012(rcvd March 6, 2012) and received April 3, 2012. This information includes, but is not limited to:

- 1) Figure 1 Waste Tire Storage Area Topography, Hardee County Regional Landfill (rcvd February 6, 2012) [Site Plan].
- 2) "Hardee County Solid Waste Department Operations Plan for Waste Tire Storage, Processing and Disposal of Processed Waste Tires" (rcvd February 6, 2012) [Op Plan].

3. **Permit Modifications.** Any construction or operation not previously approved as part of this permit shall require a separate Department permit unless the Department determines a permit modification to be more appropriate, or unless otherwise approved in writing by the Department. Permits shall be modified in accordance with the requirements of Rule 62-4.080, F.A.C. A modification which is reasonably expected to lead to substantially different environmental impacts, which require a detailed review by the Department, is considered a substantial modification.

4. **Permit Renewal.** On or **December 1, 2016**, the permittee shall notify the Department in writing or electronically of its intent to apply for renewal of this permit and of the anticipated date of submittal of the permit renewal application. **No later than March 15, 2017** the permittee shall apply for a renewal of a permit on forms and in a manner prescribed by the Department, in order to assure conformance with all applicable Department rules. Permits shall be renewed at least every five years as required by Rule 62-4.090, F.A.C. Operation permit renewal shall include, but not be limited to, an updated Operation Plan and Site Plans for existing site conditions.

5. **Professional Certification.** Where required by Chapter 471 (P.E.) or Chapter 492 (P.G.), Florida Statutes, applicable portions of permit applications and supporting documents, which are submitted to the Department for public record, shall be signed and sealed by the professional(s) who prepared or approved them.

SPECIFIC CONDITIONS: PART A -SOLID WASTE FACILITY GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

6. **General Conditions.** The permittee shall be aware of and operate under the "General Conditions". General Conditions are binding upon the permittee and enforceable pursuant to Chapter 403, Florida Statutes.

7. **Permit Acceptance.** By acceptance of this Permit, the Permittee certifies that he/she has read and understands the obligations imposed by the Specific and General Conditions contained herein and also including date of permit expiration and renewal deadlines. It is a violation of this permit for failure to comply with all conditions and deadlines.

8. **Regulations.** Chapters 62-701, effective January 6, 2010, and 62-711, effective February 12, 2012, F.A.C., are incorporated into this permit by reference. In the event that the regulations governing this permitted operation are revised, the Department shall notify the permittee, and the permittee shall request modification of those specific conditions, which are affected by the revision of regulations to incorporate those revisions.

9. **Prohibitions.** The prohibitions of Rule 62-711.400, F.A.C., shall not be violated by activities at this site.

a. Waste Burning. Open burning of solid waste is prohibited except in accordance with Rule 62-701.300(3) and Chapter 62-256, F.A.C.

SPECIFIC CONDITIONS: PART B - CONSTRUCTION REQUIREMENTS

1. **Construction.** All construction activities shall be approved by the Department prior to initiating work, unless specifically authorized otherwise.

a. This permit does not authorize construction activities at the waste tire collection center area of the site.

SPECIFIC CONDITIONS: PART C - OPERATION REQUIREMENTS

1. Facility Operation Requirements.

a. The permittee shall operate this facility in accordance with Rule 62-711.530, F.A.C., the information listed in Specific Condition #A.2.a., the facility Op Plan [ref.SC#A.2.a.(2)], and any other applicable requirements.

b. Incoming loads shall be unloaded inside the designated waste tire storage area as shown on the Site Plan [ref.SC#A.2.a.(1)].

c. In the event of a fire, additional waste shall not be accepted in the area affected by the fire until the fire is completely extinguished. All fires which require longer than one (1) hour to extinguish must be promptly reported to the Department and in accordance with Specific Condition #C.6., below.

2. Operating Personnel. An operator or spotter shall be at the waste tire area whenever waste tires are being accepted, and shall be responsible for operating and maintaining the facility in an orderly, safe, and sanitary manner

3. Control of Access. Access to, and use of, the facility is controlled by the use of fencing.

4. Monitoring of Waste. The permittee shall not knowingly accept hazardous waste or any hazardous substance at this site. Hazardous waste is a waste in Chapter 62-730, F.A.C. Hazardous substances are those defined in Section 403.703, Florida Statute or in any other applicable state or federal law or administrative rule.

5. Control of Nuisance Conditions. The owner or operator shall control vectors so as to protect the public health and welfare. The operating authority shall be responsible for the control of odors and fugitive particulates arising from the operation. Such control shall minimize the creation of nuisance conditions on adjoining property. Complaints confirmed by Department personnel upon site inspection, shall constitute a nuisance condition, and the permittee must take immediate corrective action to abate the nuisance.

SPECIFIC CONDITIONS: PART C - OPERATION REQUIREMENTS

6. Facility Maintenance and Repair.

a. The site shall be properly maintained including minimized grass, underbrush and other flammable vegetation, minimize ponding, and maintenance of berms and other systems designed to protect water bodies from liquid runoff from a potential waste tire fire. In the event of damage to any portion of the waste tire collection site facilities, equipment, storage areas, or buildings, failure of any portion of the associated systems, fire, explosion, or the development of sinkhole(s) at the site, the permittee shall **immediately (within 24 hours)** notify the Department explaining such occurrence, method to prevent reoccurrence, remedial measures to be taken and time needed for repairs. Written detailed notification shall be submitted to the Department **within seven (7) days** following the occurrence.

7. Stormwater Management. The site shall continue to have a surface water management system operated and maintained to prevent surface water flow on to unloading, loading and storage areas, and a stormwater runoff control system operated and maintained to collect and control stormwater to meet the requirements of Florida Administrative Code Rule 62-330, any other applicable Department rules, and the requirements of the respective water management district. The site shall be managed to divert stormwater around and away from the storage area.

b. Berms shall be maintained such that stormwater runoff from the waste tire collection center (WTCC) does not discharge into the wetlands located north and east of the WTCC.

8. Special Wastes. The design, operation, and monitoring of disposal or control of any "special wastes" shall be in accordance with the Operation Plan and with Rules 62-701.300(8) and 62-701.520, F.A.C., and any other applicable Department rules, to protect the public safety, health and welfare. The special wastes shall be stored and managed such that discharge of contaminants to the environment is prevented. The special wastes shall be handled on a first-in, first-out basis.

a. Wastes which may include residual contaminants (such as gasoline, oil, paint, antifreeze, PCBs, etc.) shall be stored such that the residues or constituents thereof are not spilled, leaked, dumped, or otherwise discharged onto the ground or into surface or groundwaters.

SPECIFIC CONDITIONS: PART C - OPERATION REQUIREMENTS

9. **Material Management and Storage.** All waste tires shall be stored in accordance with Rules 62-711.540 and 62-711.550, F.A.C., and the information listed in Specific Condition #A.2.a., and other applicable requirements.

a. Storage at the waste tire collection center is limited to no more than 1,500 waste tires and shall comply with the requirements of Rule 62-711.540, F.A.C.

b. If the facility has reached its permitted storage capacity, the permittee shall not accept additional waste tires until sufficient capacity has been restored.

c. At least once per year, remove all waste tires which have not been used from the site for recycling, processing, or disposal.

d. Only waste tires and rims removed from tires at the waste tire collection shall be stored at the WTCC. Other materials shall not be stored at the WTCC.

9. **Fire Safety.**

a. A fire safety inspection shall be conducted at least **annually**. The fire safety inspection report shall be maintained at the facility for five years and copies shall be provided to the Department upon request.

b. In the event that deficiencies are noted in the annual fire safety inspection report, **within 30 days** of completion, the permittee shall provide documentation to the Department indicating correction of any deficiencies noted. The documentation shall include approval of the corrections by the local fire authority.

c. Flammable, ignitable or explosive liquids or other materials shall not be stored in the vicinity of the waste tire storage area.

d. In the event of a tire fire, impacted soils and/or liquids shall be contained, and shall be characterized prior to disposal either at the onsite Class I landfill or other appropriately permitted offsite disposal facility. The results of this characterization shall be provided to the Department with the written notification required by Specific Condition #C.6.a. above, prior to disposal of the material.

SPECIFIC CONDITIONS: PART D - RECORDKEEPING

1. **Report Submittals.** Unless otherwise specified, all submittals, notifications, requests for permit modification, reports for compliance with this permit, etc. shall be sent to: Solid Waste Section, Department of Environmental Protection, Southwest District Office, 13051 North Telecom Parkway, Temple Terrace, Florida 33637-0926.
2. **Operation Plan and Operating Record.**
 - a. A copy of the Department approved permit, emergency preparedness manual, operation plan, and supporting information shall be kept at the facility at all times for reference and inspection.
 - b. The emergency preparedness manual must be shall be updated at least once per year. A copy of the updated emergency preparedness manual must be kept off-site.
 - c. Proposed changes to the current Department approved plans shall be submitted in writing to the Department for review and may require a permit modification in accordance with Specific Condition #A.3. These plans shall be updated as operations change and for renewal of the permit. Revised pages shall be provided as replacement pages with revisions noted (deletions may be struckthrough [~~struckthrough~~] and additions may be underlined [underlined] or a similar method may be used) and each page numbered with the document title and date of revision.
3. **Waste Records.**
 - a. Operational records shall be recorded and maintained for a minimum of **three years** and be available for inspection by Department personnel during normal business hours.
 - b. The owner or operator of the waste tire collection facility shall record the quantity of waste tires collected, where or from whom the waste tires were collected, the quantity stored at the site, the quantity shipped from the site for disposal, and where the waste tires were disposed.
 - c. The following reports, documents and other information shall be kept at the facility for reference, and copies shall be provided to the Department upon request:
 - 1) A log of the facility operator's inspections, and any subsequent corrective actions; and
 - 2) A copy of the facility's Emergency Preparedness Manual shall be kept at the site and documentation of any annual updates.



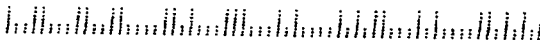

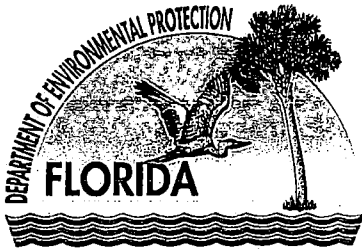

Attached is **Permit 129318-004-WT/05**, issued pursuant to Section(s) 403.087(1), Florida Statutes. This letter and its attachments constitute a **complete permit**, and **replace** all previous permits and permit modifications for the above referenced facility.

The Department's proposed agency action shall become final unless a timely petition for an administrative hearing is filed under Sections 120.569 and 120.57, Florida Statutes (F.S.), before the deadline for filing a petition. The procedures for petitioning for a hearing are set forth below.

A person whose substantial interests are affected by the Department's proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrative proceeding (hearing) under Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S. The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed (received) in the Office of General Counsel of the Department at 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Mail Station 35, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3000.

Petitions by the applicant or any of the parties listed below must be filed within 14 days of receipt of this written notice. Petitions filed by other persons must be filed within 14 days of publication of the notice or receipt of the written notice, whichever occurs first. Under Section 120.60(3), F.S., however, any person who asked the Department for notice of agency action may file a petition within fourteen days of receipt of such notice, regardless of the date of publication. The petitioner shall mail a copy of the petition to

the applicant at the address indicated above at the time of filing. The failure of any person to file a petition within the appropriate time period shall constitute a waiver of that person's right to request an administrative determination (hearing) under Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S., or to intervene in this proceeding and participate as a party to it. Any subsequent intervention (in a proceeding initiated by another party) will be only at the discretion of the presiding officer upon the filing of a motion in compliance with Rule 28-106.205, F.A.C.

A petition that disputes the material facts on which the Department's action is based must contain the following information:

- (a) The name, address, and telephone number of each petitioner, the applicant's name and address, the Department File Number and the county in which the project is proposed;
- (b) A statement of how and when each petitioner received notice of the Department's action or proposed action;
- (c) A statement of how each petitioner's substantial interests are or will be affected by the Department's action or proposed action;
- (d) A statement of all material facts disputed by petitioner or a statement that there are no disputed facts;
- (e) A statement of the ultimate facts alleged, including a statement of the specific facts, which the petitioner contends, warrant reversal or modification of the Department's action or proposed action;
- (f) A statement of the specific rules or statutes the petitioner contends require reversal or modification of the Department's action or proposed action; and
- (g) A statement of the relief sought by the petitioner, stating precisely the action the petitioner wants the Department to take with respect to the Department's action or proposed action.

A petition that does not dispute the material facts on which the Department's action is based shall state that no such facts are in dispute and otherwise shall contain the same information as set forth above, as required by Rule 28-106.301, F.A.C.

Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filing of a petition means that the Department's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this notice. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision of the Department have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding, in accordance with the requirements set forth above.

In accordance with Section 120.573, F.S., the Department advises that mediation is not available in this case under the provisions of



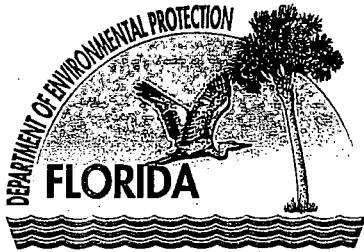

This permit is issued under the provisions of Chapter 403, Florida Statutes, and Florida Administrative Code Rule(s) 62-4, 62-701, and 62-711. The above named permittee is hereby authorized to perform the work or operate the facility shown on the application and approved drawing(s), plans and other documents, attached hereto or referenced in Specific Condition #A.2. and made a part hereof and specifically described as follows:

To operate a waste tire collection facility located at the **Hardee County waste tire collection center**, located on Airport Road, near the City of Wauchula, Hardee County, Florida. The specific conditions attached are for the operation of:

1. Waste Tire Collection Center

General Information: This facility accepts tires from the general public for temporary storage prior to being transferred to a processing facility for recycling, reuse or disposal. Maximum storage capacity for this facility is no more than 1500 tires.

Replaces Permit No.: 129318-003-WT/05

This permit contains compliance items summarized in Attachment 1 that shall be complied with and submitted to the Department by the dates noted. If the compliance dates are not met and submittals are not received by the Department on the dates noted, enforcement action may be initiated to assure compliance with the conditions of this permit.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

1. The terms, conditions, requirements, limitations and restrictions set forth in this permit, are "permit conditions" and are binding and enforceable pursuant to Sections 403.141, 403.161, 403.727, or 403.861, Florida Statutes. The permittee is placed on notice that the Department will review this permit periodically and may initiate enforcement action for any violation of these conditions.
2. This permit is valid only for the specific processes and operations applied for and indicated in the approved drawings or exhibits. Any unauthorized deviation from the approved drawings, exhibits, specifications, or conditions of this permit may constitute grounds for revocation and enforcement action by the Department.
3. As provided in subsections 403.087(6) and 403.722(5), F.S., the issuance of this permit does not convey any vested rights or any exclusive privileges. Neither does it authorize any injury to public or private property or any invasion of rights, nor any infringement of federal, State, or local laws or regulations. This permit is not a waiver of or approval of any other Department permit that may be required for other aspects of the total project which are not addressed in this permit.
4. This permit conveys no title to land or water, does not constitute State recognition or acknowledgment of title, and does not constitute authority for the use of submerged lands unless herein provided and the necessary title or leasehold interests have been obtained from the State. Only the Trustees of the Internal Improvement Trust Fund may express State opinion as to title.
5. This permit does not relieve the permittee from liability for harm or injury to human health or welfare, animal, or plant life, or property caused by the construction or operation of this permitted source, or from penalties therefore; nor does it allow the permittee to cause pollution in contravention of Florida Statutes and Department rules, unless specifically authorized by an order from the Department.
6. The permittee shall properly operate and maintain the facility and systems of treatment and control (and related appurtenances) that are installed and used by the permittee to achieve compliance with the conditions of this permit, are required by Department rules. This provision includes the operation of backup or auxiliary facilities or similar systems when necessary to achieve compliance with the conditions of the permit and when required by Department rules.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

7. The permittee, by accepting this permit, specifically agrees to allow authorized Department personnel, upon presentation of credentials or other documents as may be required by law and at reasonable times, access to the premises where the permitted activity is located or conducted to:

- (a) Have access to and copy any records that must be kept under conditions of the permit;
- (b) Inspect the facility, equipment, practices, or operations regulated or required under this permit; and
- (c) Sample or monitor any substances or parameters at any location reasonably necessary to assure compliance with this permit or Department rules.

Reasonable time may depend on the nature of the concern being investigated.

8. If, for any reason, the permittee does not comply with or will be unable to comply with any condition or limitation specified in this permit, the permittee shall immediately provide the Department with the following information:

- (a) A description of and cause of noncompliance; and
- (b) The period of noncompliance, including dates and times; or, if not corrected, the anticipated time the noncompliance is expected to continue, and steps being taken to reduce, eliminate, and prevent recurrence of the noncompliance.

The permittee shall be responsible for any and all damages which may result and may be subject to enforcement action by the Department for penalties or for revocation of this permit.

9. In accepting this permit, the permittee understands and agrees that all records, notes, monitoring data and other information relating to the construction or operation of this permitted source which are submitted to the Department may be used by the Department as evidence in any enforcement case involving the permitted source arising under the Florida Statutes or Department rules, except where such use is prescribed by Sections 403.111 and 403.73, F.S. Such evidence shall only be used to the extent it is consistent with the Florida Rules of Civil Procedure and appropriate evidentiary rules.

10. The permittee agrees to comply with changes in Department rules and Florida Statutes after a reasonable time for compliance; provided, however, the permittee does not waive any other rights granted by Florida Statutes or Department rules.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

11. This permit is transferable only upon Department approval in accordance with Rule 62-4.120 and 62-730.300, Florida Administrative Code, as applicable. The permittee shall be liable for any non-compliance of the permitted activity until the transfer is approved by the Department.

12. This permit or a copy thereof shall be kept at the work site of the permitted activity.

13. This permit also constitutes:

- (a) Determination of Best Available Control Technology (BACT)
- (b) Determination of Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD)
- (c) Certification of compliance with State Water Quality Standards (Section 401, PL 92-500)
- (d) Compliance with New Source Performance Standards

14. The permittee shall comply with the following:

- (a) Upon request, the permittee shall furnish all records and plans required under Department rules. During enforcement actions, the retention period for all records will be extended automatically unless otherwise stipulated by the Department.
- (b) The permittee shall hold at the facility or other location designated by this permit records of all monitoring information (including all calibration and maintenance records and all original strip chart recordings for continuous monitoring instrumentation) required by the permit, copies of all reports required by this permit, and records of all data used to complete the application for this permit. These materials shall be retained at least three years from the date of the sample, measurement, report, or application unless otherwise specified by Department rule.
- (c) Records of monitoring information shall include:
 - 1. the date, exact place, and time of sampling or measurements;
 - 2. the person responsible for performing the sampling or measurements;
 - 3. the dates analyses were performed;
 - 4. the person responsible for performing the analyses;
 - 5. the analytical techniques or methods used;
 - 6. the results of such analyses.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

15. When requested by the Department, the permittee shall within a reasonable time furnish any information required by law which is needed to determine compliance with the permit. If the permittee becomes aware the relevant facts were not submitted or were incorrect in the permit application or in any report to the Department, such facts or information shall be corrected promptly.

SPECIFIC CONDITIONS: PART A -SOLID WASTE FACILITY GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

1. **Facility Designation.** This site shall be classified as a waste tire collection center and shall be operated, maintained and closed in accordance with all applicable requirements of Chapters 62-4, 62-711, and 62-701, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.).

2. **Permit Application Documentation.** This permit is valid for operation of the waste tire collection center in accordance with all applicable requirements of Department rules and the reports, plans and other information submitted by the permittee, as follows:

a. Renewal of Waste Tire Small Processing Facility Permit Application, dated January 23, 2012 (rcvd February 6, 2012), as revised, replaced or amended by information dated March 5, 2012 (rcvd March 6, 2012) and received April 3, 2012. This information includes, but is not limited to:

- 1) Figure 1 Waste Tire Storage Area Topography, Hardee County Regional Landfill (rcvd February 6, 2012) [Site Plan].
- 2) "Hardee County Solid Waste Department Operations Plan for Waste Tire Storage, Processing and Disposal of Processed Waste Tires" (rcvd February 6, 2012) [Op Plan].

3. **Permit Modifications.** Any construction or operation not previously approved as part of this permit shall require a separate Department permit unless the Department determines a permit modification to be more appropriate, or unless otherwise approved in writing by the Department. Permits shall be modified in accordance with the requirements of Rule 62-4.080, F.A.C. A modification which is reasonably expected to lead to substantially different environmental impacts, which require a detailed review by the Department, is considered a substantial modification.

4. **Permit Renewal.** On or **December 1, 2016**, the permittee shall notify the Department in writing or electronically of its intent to apply for renewal of this permit and of the anticipated date of submittal of the permit renewal application. **No later than March 15, 2017** the permittee shall apply for a renewal of a permit on forms and in a manner prescribed by the Department, in order to assure conformance with all applicable Department rules. Permits shall be renewed at least every five years as required by Rule 62-4.090, F.A.C. Operation permit renewal shall include, but not be limited to, an updated Operation Plan and Site Plans for existing site conditions.

5. **Professional Certification.** Where required by Chapter 471 (P.E.) or Chapter 492 (P.G.), Florida Statutes, applicable portions of permit applications and supporting documents, which are submitted to the Department for public record, shall be signed and sealed by the professional(s) who prepared or approved them.

SPECIFIC CONDITIONS: PART A -SOLID WASTE FACILITY GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

6. **General Conditions.** The permittee shall be aware of and operate under the "General Conditions". General Conditions are binding upon the permittee and enforceable pursuant to Chapter 403, Florida Statutes.

7. **Permit Acceptance.** By acceptance of this Permit, the Permittee certifies that he/she has read and understands the obligations imposed by the Specific and General Conditions contained herein and also including date of permit expiration and renewal deadlines. It is a violation of this permit for failure to comply with all conditions and deadlines.

8. **Regulations.** Chapters 62-701, effective January 6, 2010, and 62-711, effective February 12, 2012, F.A.C., are incorporated into this permit by reference. In the event that the regulations governing this permitted operation are revised, the Department shall notify the permittee, and the permittee shall request modification of those specific conditions, which are affected by the revision of regulations to incorporate those revisions.

9. **Prohibitions.** The prohibitions of Rule 62-711.400, F.A.C., shall not be violated by activities at this site.

a. Waste Burning. Open burning of solid waste is prohibited except in accordance with Rule 62-701.300(3) and Chapter 62-256, F.A.C.

SPECIFIC CONDITIONS: PART B - CONSTRUCTION REQUIREMENTS

1. **Construction.** All construction activities shall be approved by the Department prior to initiating work, unless specifically authorized otherwise.

a. This permit does not authorize construction activities at the waste tire collection center area of the site.

SPECIFIC CONDITIONS: PART C - OPERATION REQUIREMENTS

1. **Facility Operation Requirements.**
 - a. The permittee shall operate this facility in accordance with Rule 62-711.530, F.A.C., the information listed in Specific Condition #A.2.a., the facility Op Plan [ref. SC#A.2.a.(2)], and any other applicable requirements.
 - b. Incoming loads shall be unloaded inside the designated waste tire storage area as shown on the Site Plan [ref. SC#A.2.a.(1)].
 - c. In the event of a fire, additional waste shall not be accepted in the area affected by the fire until the fire is completely extinguished. All fires which require longer than one (1) hour to extinguish must be promptly reported to the Department and in accordance with Specific Condition #C.6., below.
2. **Operating Personnel.** An operator or spotter shall be at the waste tire area whenever waste tires are being accepted, and shall be responsible for operating and maintaining the facility in an orderly, safe, and sanitary manner
3. **Control of Access.** Access to, and use of, the facility is controlled by the use of fencing.
4. **Monitoring of Waste.** The permittee shall not knowingly accept hazardous waste or any hazardous substance at this site. Hazardous waste is a waste in Chapter 62-730, F.A.C. Hazardous substances are those defined in Section 403.703, Florida Statute or in any other applicable state or federal law or administrative rule.
5. **Control of Nuisance Conditions.** The owner or operator shall control vectors so as to protect the public health and welfare. The operating authority shall be responsible for the control of odors and fugitive particulates arising from the operation. Such control shall minimize the creation of nuisance conditions on adjoining property. Complaints confirmed by Department personnel upon site inspection, shall constitute a nuisance condition, and the permittee must take immediate corrective action to abate the nuisance.

SPECIFIC CONDITIONS: PART C - OPERATION REQUIREMENTS

6. Facility Maintenance and Repair.

a. The site shall be properly maintained including minimized grass, underbrush and other flammable vegetation, minimize ponding, and maintenance of berms and other systems designed to protect water bodies from liquid runoff from a potential waste tire fire. In the event of damage to any portion of the waste tire collection site facilities, equipment, storage areas, or buildings, failure of any portion of the associated systems, fire, explosion, or the development of sinkhole(s) at the site, the permittee shall **immediately (within 24 hours)** notify the Department explaining such occurrence, method to prevent reoccurrence, remedial measures to be taken and time needed for repairs. Written detailed notification shall be submitted to the Department **within seven (7) days** following the occurrence.

7. Stormwater Management. The site shall continue to have a surface water management system operated and maintained to prevent surface water flow on to unloading, loading and storage areas, and a stormwater runoff control system operated and maintained to collect and control stormwater to meet the requirements of Florida Administrative Code Rule 62-330, any other applicable Department rules, and the requirements of the respective water management district. The site shall be managed to divert stormwater around and away from the storage area.

b. Berms shall be maintained such that stormwater runoff from the waste tire collection center (WTCC) does not discharge into the wetlands located north and east of the WTCC.

8. Special Wastes. The design, operation, and monitoring of disposal or control of any "special wastes" shall be in accordance with the Operation Plan and with Rules 62-701.300(8) and 62-701.520, F.A.C., and any other applicable Department rules, to protect the public safety, health and welfare. The special wastes shall be stored and managed such that discharge of contaminants to the environment is prevented. The special wastes shall be handled on a first-in, first-out basis.

a. Wastes which may include residual contaminants (such as gasoline, oil, paint, antifreeze, PCBs, etc.) shall be stored such that the residues or constituents thereof are not spilled, leaked, dumped, or otherwise discharged onto the ground or into surface or groundwaters.

SPECIFIC CONDITIONS: PART C - OPERATION REQUIREMENTS

9. **Material Management and Storage.** All waste tires shall be stored in accordance with Rules 62-711.540 and 62-711.550, F.A.C., and the information listed in Specific Condition #A.2.a., and other applicable requirements.

a. Storage at the waste tire collection center is limited to no more than 1,500 waste tires and shall comply with the requirements of Rule 62-711.540, F.A.C.

b. If the facility has reached its permitted storage capacity, the permittee shall not accept additional waste tires until sufficient capacity has been restored.

c. At least once per year, remove all waste tires which have not been used from the site for recycling, processing, or disposal.

d. Only waste tires and rims removed from tires at the waste tire collection shall be stored at the WTCC. Other materials shall not be stored at the WTCC.

9. **Fire Safety.**

a. A fire safety inspection shall be conducted at least **annually**. The fire safety inspection report shall be maintained at the facility for five years and copies shall be provided to the Department upon request.

b. In the event that deficiencies are noted in the annual fire safety inspection report, **within 30 days** of completion, the permittee shall provide documentation to the Department indicating correction of any deficiencies noted. The documentation shall include approval of the corrections by the local fire authority.

c. Flammable, ignitable or explosive liquids or other materials shall not be stored in the vicinity of the waste tire storage area.

d. In the event of a tire fire, impacted soils and/or liquids shall be contained, and shall be characterized prior to disposal either at the onsite Class I landfill or other appropriately permitted offsite disposal facility. The results of this characterization shall be provided to the Department with the written notification required by Specific Condition #C.6.a. above, prior to disposal of the material.

SPECIFIC CONDITIONS: PART D - RECORDKEEPING

1. **Report Submittals.** Unless otherwise specified, all submittals, notifications, requests for permit modification, reports for compliance with this permit, etc. shall be sent to: Solid Waste Section, Department of Environmental Protection, Southwest District Office, 13051 North Telecom Parkway, Temple Terrace, Florida 33637-0926.
2. **Operation Plan and Operating Record.**
 - a. A copy of the Department approved permit, emergency preparedness manual, operation plan, and supporting information shall be kept at the facility at all times for reference and inspection.
 - b. The emergency preparedness manual must be shall be updated at least once per year. A copy of the updated emergency preparedness manual must be kept off-site.
 - c. Proposed changes to the current Department approved plans shall be submitted in writing to the Department for review and may require a permit modification in accordance with Specific Condition #A.3. These plans shall be updated as operations change and for renewal of the permit. Revised pages shall be provided as replacement pages with revisions noted (deletions may be struckthrough [~~struckthrough~~] and additions may be underlined [underlined] or a similar method may be used) and each page numbered with the document title and date of revision.
3. **Waste Records.**
 - a. Operational records shall be recorded and maintained for a minimum of **three years** and be available for inspection by Department personnel during normal business hours.
 - b. The owner or operator of the waste tire collection facility shall record the quantity of waste tires collected, where or from whom the waste tires were collected, the quantity stored at the site, the quantity shipped from the site for disposal, and where the waste tires were disposed.
 - c. The following reports, documents and other information shall be kept at the facility for reference, and copies shall be provided to the Department upon request:
 - 1) A log of the facility operator's inspections, and any subsequent corrective actions; and
 - 2) A copy of the facility's Emergency Preparedness Manual shall be kept at the site and documentation of any annual updates.

OPERATIONS PLAN FOR WASTE TIRE STORAGE, PROCESSING AND DISPOSAL OF PROCESSED WASTE TIRES

STORAGE:

Hardee County Solid Waste Department is located at 685 Airport Road, three miles East of Wauchula off of Highway 636. The waste tire disposal site is located on the East side of the Class I Landfill access road. The site is approximately 158' L X 178' W and is constructed on clay subsurface with a compacted shell base. (See attached site map.) The site is posted waste tires only...Rates are posted when entering the landfill or given out upon request by phone.

Upon entering the landfill each vehicle must pass over the scales. All loads of tires are charged a "\$125 per ton rate". The scale house attendant will weigh the vehicle, classify the load as waste tires, contact one of the three spotters/operator that are equipped with handheld radios that there is a vehicle coming to the tire site then directs the vehicle to the waste tire site and/or trailer. The operator/spotter will meet the driver at the site to instruct and assist resident in the vehicle. Tires are stacked upright in rows in the center of the site then loaded into a boxed semi trailer.

A 50' wide fire lane around the perimeter of the site is keep free of grass, under and any other vegetation. The site is secured with a barrier fence, gate and pad locks, which surround the entire landfill. The Solid Waste Department does not conduct any operations involving the use of an open flame anywhere on site.

Quarterly reports and annual summaries are submitted to the Tampa District Department of Environmental Protection. Quarterly or annual summaries are also available at the Hardee County Solid Waste Department's administrative office.

OFF-SITE -

Hardee County Solid Waste Department contacts Garden Street Iron & Metal of S.W. FL. INC for removal and off site processing of waste tires. This company is permitted through the Florida Department of Environmental Protections for collection, transporting, storage and processing of waste tires. All size, whole waste tires, both on an off rims, are collected on a regularly scheduled basis, but not less than monthly, the weight of the tires collected is recorded at the landfill scale house.

RECORD KEEPING-

Hardee County Solid Waste Department keeps daily , monthly, and yearly tonnages of all waste tires disposed of at the landfill, a quarterly report is sent tot the Department of Environmental Protections on January 20th, April 20th, August 20th, and October 20th for the department review. Financial assurance is calculated annually and submitted to the Department of Environmental Protection for their approval.

4. Smother fire by covering it with a blanket of dirt
5. If waste is used, block the northwest corner of the storm water ditch with available soil to prevent any runoff.
6. Oily material to be maintained within berm area of the site.
7. Contact DEP with a full report.
8. Clean up oily contaminated dirt and ship to certified Hazardous Waste Disposal Facility.

Note: The site is large enough to maneuver equipment such as the front end loader and dozer. In addition, there are sufficient amounts of cover material located at the Class I landfill adjacent to the site, to smother a potential fire. The maximum time between any potential incident and the removal of any fire residue is within 24 hours. It is unlikely that water will be used to extinguish any fires. However, should there be a need to use water, the storm water control system can quickly be berm off and the water collected on site pumped across the road to the leachate tanks for off site for treatment.

SITE CLOSURE PLAN

Upon Board of County Commissioner's decision to close the Waste Tire Storage Site, the following procedures are to be followed:

- Stop public access to the site by placing a berm of soil at the entrance or fencing off entrance.
- Post a notice at the site that the site is closed and give the phone number of the Solid Waste Department.
- Notify the district Department of Environmental Protections that the site is closed.
- Remove all waste tires shipping to a permitted facility.
- If any soil contamination is found, remove soil and ship to a permitted Hazardous Waste Facility or test soil for disposal into a Class I Landfill.

Closure of this site can be completed within thirty days of notification. In reference to rule 62.711.700(3) (d), proof of financial assurance is provided in the annual cost closure estimates and escrowed into the Solid Waste Landfill Closure Trust Fund account.

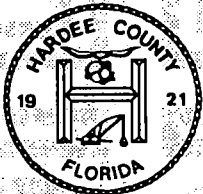
