This permit is issued under the provisions of Chapter 403, Florida Statutes, and Florida Administrative Code Rule(s) 17-3, 17-4, 17-7 and 17-25. The above named permittee is hereby authorized to perform the work or operate the facility shown on the application and approved drawing(s), plans, and other documents, attached hereto or on file with department and made a part hereof and specifically described as follows:

To operate a solid waste volume reduction facility (approximately 10 acres), referred to as Hardee County Class III Volume Reduction Facility, subject to the specific conditions attached, storing and processing solid waste, near Airport Road and S.R. 64A, northeast of Wauchula, Hardee County, Florida.

Hardee County Class III Volume Reduction Facility

SPECIFIC CONDITIONS:

1. This site shall be classified as a solid waste volume reduction facility, and shall be constructed and operated in accordance with all applicable requirements of Chapters 17-2, 17-3, 17-4, 17-7 and 17-25, Florida Administrative Code.
2. The operating authority shall be responsible for the control of odors and fugitive particulates arising from this operation. Such control shall prevent the creation of nuisance conditions on adjoining property. Complaints received from the general public shall constitute a nuisance condition and the permittee shall take immediate corrective action to abate the nuisance.
3. The permittee shall not accept hazardous waste or any hazardous substance at this site. Hazardous waste is a solid waste identified by the Department as a hazardous waste in Chapter 17-30, Florida Administrative Code. Hazardous substances are those defined in Section 403.703(29) Florida Statute or in any other applicable state or federal law or administrative rule.
4. Solid Waste stored longer than twelve months at the volume reduction facility shall be disposed of properly in the Hardee County Class I Sanitary Landfill.
5. Air curtain incineration shall be designed and operated to meet all applicable rules of the Department including F.A.C. Chapters 17-2 and 17-3. This permit is valid for the construction/installation, and subsequent operation of the air curtain incinerator, subject to issuance of an air pollution source permit as necessary.
6. White goods, or other discarded materials except yard trash, that are held for the purposes of recycling in the Class III area shall be held no longer than ninety (90) days unless covered, and shall be stored in a manner so as not to constitute a fire or safety hazard or a sanitary nuisance, and shall comply with all applicable local and state regulations. Surface water shall be diverted away from all storage or holding areas. An adequate paving and drainage plan shall be submitted to the Department, C/O Solid Waste Section, Southwest District Office, 30 days prior to related construction. Any processing or volume reduction of white goods, or other discarded materials except yard trash, will require a modification of this permit.
7. At least 10 days prior to each week designated for processing, the permittee shall notify the Solid Waste Section of this office of the week designated for processing.

SPECIFIC CONDITIONS (cont'd)

8. All solid wastes, recovered materials or residues handled at the volume reduction facility shall be stored in a manner so as not to constitute a fire or safety hazard or a sanitary nuisance, and shall comply with all applicable local and state regulations. Recovered resources resulting from the volume reduction facility and which may be offered for sale shall comply with applicable regulations of all appropriate state agencies.

9. The facility shall have a surface water management system designed, constructed, operated, and maintained to prevent surface water flow onto storage and processing areas, and a stormwater runoff control system designed, constructed, operated and maintained to collect and control stormwater to meet requirements of Florida Administrative Code Rule 17-25 and requirements of the respective water management district.

10. Stormwater or other surface water which comes into contact with the solid waste or mixed with leachate shall be considered leachate, and shall be treated to meet applicable standards of Florida Administrative Code Rules 17-3, 17-4, and 17-6 at the point of discharge.


11. After all significant construction or phase of the facility has been completed, the engineer or the authorized public officer shall complete a Certification of Construction Completion, Department Form 17-7.130(2).

12. Prior to 60 days before the expiration of the Department Permit, the permittee shall apply for a renewal of a permit on forms and in a manner prescribed by the Department, in order to assure conformance with all applicable Department rules.

13. The permittee shall be aware of and operate under the attached "General Conditions". General Conditions are binding upon the permittee and enforceable pursuant to Chapter 403, Florida Statutes.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

1. The terms, conditions, requirements, limitations, and restrictions set forth herein are "Permit Conditions" and as such are binding upon the permittee and enforceable pursuant to the authority of Sections 403.161, 403.727, or 403.859 through 403.861, Florida Statutes. The permittee is hereby placed on notice that the department will review this permit periodically and may initiate the enforcement action for any violation of the "Permit Conditions" by the permittee, its agent, employees, servants or representatives.
2. This permit is valid only for the specific processes and operations applied for and indicated in the approved drawings or exhibits. Any unauthorized deviation from the approved drawings, exhibits, specifications, or conditions of this permit may constitute grounds for revocation and enforcement action by the department.
3. As provided in Subsections 403.087(6) and 403.722(5), Florida Statutes, the issuance of this permit does not convey any vested rights or any exclusive privileges. Nor does it authorize any injury to public or private property or any invasion of personal rights, nor any infringement of federal, state or local laws or regulations. This permit does not constitute a waiver of or approval of any other department permit that may be required for other aspects of the total project which are not addressed in the permit.
4. This permit conveys no title to land or water, does not constitute state recognition or acknowledgement of title, and does not constitute authority for the use of submerged lands unless herein provided and the necessary title or leasehold interests have been obtained from the state. Only the Trustees of the Internal Improvement Trust Fund may express state opinion as to title.
5. This permit does not relieve the permittee from liability for harm or injury to human health or welfare, animal, plant or aquatic life or property and penalties therefore caused by the construction or operation of this permitted source, nor does it allow the permittee to cause pollution in contravention of Florida Statutes and department rules, unless specifically authorized by any order from the department.
6. The permittee shall at all times properly operate and maintain the facility and systems of treatment and control (and related appurtenances) that are installed or used by the permittee to achieve compliance with the conditions of this permit, as required by department rules. This provision includes the operation of backup or auxiliary facilities or similar systems when necessary to achieve compliance with the conditions of the permit and when required by department rules.
7. The permittee, by accepting this permit, specifically agrees to allow authorized department personnel, upon presentation of credentials or other documents as may be required by law, access to the premises, at reasonable times, where the permitted activity is located or conducted for the purposes of:
 - a. Having access to and copying any records that must be kept under the conditions of the permit:

GENERAL CONDITIONS (con't):

b. Inspecting the facility, equipment, practices, or operations regulated or required under this permit; and

c. Sampling or monitoring any substances or parameters at any location reasonably necessary to assure compliance with this permit or department rules.

Reasonable time may depend on the nature of the concern being investigated.

8. If, for any reason, the permittee does not comply with or will be unable to comply with any condition or limitation specified in this permit, the permittee shall immediately notify and provide the department with the following information:

(a) a description of and cause of non-compliance; and

(b) the period of non-compliance, including exact dates and times; or, if not corrected, the anticipated time the non-compliance is expected to continue, and steps being taken to reduce, eliminate, and prevent recurrence of the non-compliance.

The permittee shall be responsible for any and all damages which may result and may be subject to enforcement action by the department for penalties or revocation of this permit.

9. In accepting this permit, the permittee understands and agrees that all records, notes, monitoring data and other information relating to the construction or operation of this permitted source, which are submitted to the department, may be used by the department as evidence in any enforcement case arising under the Florida Statutes or department rules, except where such use is prescribed by Sections 403.73 and 403.111, Florida Statutes.

10. The permittee agrees to comply with changes in department rules and Florida Statutes after a reasonable time for compliance, provided, however, the permittee does not waive any other rights granted by Florida Statutes or department rules.

11. This permit is transferable only upon department approval in accordance with Florida Administrative Code Rules 17-4.12 and 17-30.30, as applicable. The permittee shall be liable for any non-compliance of the permitted activity until the transfer is approved by the department.

12. This permit is required to be kept at the work site of the permitted activity during the entire period of construction or operation.

13. This permit also constitutes:

() Determination of Best Available Control
Technology (BACT)

() Determination of Prevention of Significant
Deterioration (PSD)

- () Certification of Compliance with State Water Quality Standards (Section 401. PL 92-500)
- () Compliance with New Source Performance Standards

14. The permittee shall comply with the following monitoring and record keeping requirements:

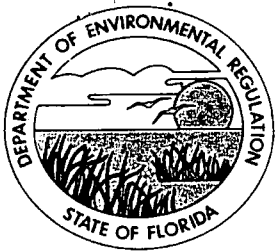
a. Upon request, the permittee shall furnish all records and plans required under department rules. The retention period for all records will be extended automatically, unless otherwise stipulated by the department, during the course of any unresolved enforcement action.

b. The permittee shall retain at the facility or other location designated by this permit records of all monitoring information (including all calibration and maintenance records and all original strip chart recordings for continuous monitoring instrumentation), copies of all reports required by this permit, and records of all data used to complete the application for this permit. The time period of retention shall be at least three years from the date of the sample, measurement, report or application unless otherwise specified by department rule.

c. Records of monitoring information shall include:

- the date, exact place, and time of sampling or measurement;
- the person responsible for performing the sampling or measurements;
- the date(s) analyses were performed;
- the person responsible for performing the analyses;
- the analytical techniques or methods used; and
- the results of such analyses.

15. When requested by the department, the permittee shall within a reasonable time furnish any information required by law which is needed to determine compliance with the permit. If the permittee becomes aware that relevant facts were not submitted or were incorrect in the permit application or in any report to the department, such facts or information shall be submitted or corrected promptly.

Enclosed is Permit Number SO25-164435 to operate a volume reduction facility, issued pursuant to Section(s) 403.087(1), Florida Statutes.

Persons whose substantial interests are affected by this permit have a right, pursuant to Section 120.57, Florida Statutes, to petition for an administrative determination (hearing) on it. The petition must conform to the requirements of Chapters 17-103 and 28-5.201, F.A.C., and must be filed (received) in the Department's Office of General Counsel, 2600 Blair Stone Road, Tallahassee 32301, within fourteen (14) days of receipt of this notice. Failure to file a petition within the fourteen (14) days constitutes a waiver of any right such person has to an administrative determination (hearing) pursuant to Section 120.57, Florida Statutes. This permit is final and effective on the date filed with the Clerk of the Department unless a request for extension of time in which to file a petition is filed within the time specified for filing a petition and conforms to Rule 17-103.070, F.A.C. Upon timely filing of a petition or a request for an extension of time this permit will not be effective until further Order of the Department.



RULES OF THE ADMINISTRATION COMMISSION, MODEL RULES OF PROCEDURE
CHAPTER 28-5, DECISIONS DETERMINING SUBSTANTIAL INTERESTS
PART II, FORMAL HEARINGS
A) PREHEARING PROCEDURES

28-5.201 Initiation of Formal Proceedings.

(1) Initiation of formal proceedings shall be made by petition to the Agency responsible for rendering final Agency action. The term petition as used herein includes any application or other document which expresses a request for formal proceedings. Each petition should be printed, typewritten or otherwise duplicated in legible form on white paper of standard legal size. Unless printed, the impression shall be on one side of the paper only and lines shall be double-spaced and indented.

(2) All petitions filed under these rules should contain:

(a) The name and address of each Agency affected and each Agency's file or identification number, if known;

(b) The name and address of the petitioner or petitioners, and an explanation of how his/her substantial interests will be affected by the Agency determination;

(c) A statement of when and how petitioner received notice of the Agency decision of intent to render a decision;

(d) A statement of all disputed issues of material fact. If there are none, the petition must so indicate;

(e) A concise statement of the ultimate facts alleged, as well as the rules and statutes which entitle the petitioner to relief;

(f) A demand for relief to which the petitioner deems himself entitled; and

(g) Other information which the petitioner contends is material.

(3) Upon receipt of a petition for formal proceedings, the Agency shall either accept or deny the petition, and if accepted shall elect either to conduct the hearing itself through the Agency head, or member thereof, assign a person authorized by Subsection 120.57(1)(a) or other authority, or request that a Hearing Officer from the Division of Administrative Hearings be assigned to conduct the hearing.

(a) A petition may be denied if the petitioner does not state adequately a material factual allegation, such as a substantial interest in the Agency determination, or if the petition is untimely.

(b) The Agency shall promptly give written notice to all parties of the action taken on the petition, and shall state with particularity its reasons therefor.

(4) If the Agency elects to request that a Hearing Officer of the Division of Administrative Hearings be assigned to conduct the hearing, the Agency shall forward the petition, and all materials filed with the Agency, to the Division of Administrative hearings, and shall notify all parties of its action.

Section 17-103.155, Florida Administrative Code
Rules of Administrative Procedure
Final Agency Action (Non-Rulemaking) and Appeal

17-103.155 Petition for Administrative Hearing; Waiver of Right to Administrative Proceeding.

(1)(a) Any person whose substantial interests may be affected by proposed or final agency action by the Department may file a petition for formal administrative hearing in accordance with this rule if the person disputes the material facts upon which the Department's action is based.

(b) Any person whose substantial interests may be affected by proposed or final action by the Department may file a petition for informal administrative hearing in accordance with this rule if the person objects to the Department's action but does not dispute the material facts upon which the Department's action is based.

(2) A petition for formal or informal administrative hearing pursuant to Section 120.57, F.S., shall contain the following information:

(a) The name, address, and telephone number of each petitioner. If the petitioner challenges a Department action or proposed action on a permit application, the applicant's name and address, the Department Permit File Number and the county in which the project is proposed shall also be included;

(b) A statement of how and when each petitioner received notices of the Department action or proposed action;

(c) A statement of how each petitioner's substantial interests are affected by the Department's action or proposed action;

(d) A statement of those material facts (i.e., those facts upon which the Department's action or proposal is based) is disputed by petitioner. If no facts are disputed, petitioner shall so state;

(e) A statement of facts which petitioner contends warrant reversal or modification of the Department's action or proposed action;

(f) A statement of which rules or statutes petitioner contends require reversal or modification of the Department's action or proposed action;

(g) A statement of relief sought by petitioner, stating precisely the action petitioner wants the Department to take with respect to the Department's action or proposed action.

(3)(a) A petition shall be in the form required by this rule and must be filed (received) in the Office of General Counsel of the Department within the following number of days after receipt or publication (whichever occurs first) of notice of proposed agency action or of notice of agency action:

1. Petitions concerning Department action or proposed action on applications for permits (except permits for hazardous waste facilities): 45 days;

2. Petitions concerning Department action or proposed action on applications for hazardous waste facility permits: 45 days;

3. Petitions concerning notices of violation when no informal conference is held: 20 days after receipt of the notice of violation;

4. Petitions concerning notices of violation when an informal conference is held: 10 days after receipt of notice of completion of the informal conference;

5. Petitions concerning other Department actions or proposed actions: 21 days. The petitioner shall also serve a copy of the petition on all other parties to the proceeding, as identified in the published notice, at the time of filing.

(b) Failure to timely file a petition within the applicable time period after receipt of notice of agency action or receipt of notice of proposed agency action, whichever notice first occurs, shall constitute a waiver if any right to request an administrative proceeding under Chapter 120, F.S.

(4) If a petition is filed that does not substantially comply with the requirements of subsection (2) of this rule, the Department shall issue an order dismissing the petition with leave to file an amended petition complying with the requirements of this rule within 15 days of service of the order. If an amended petition complying with this rule is not filed (received) within 15 days of service of the order, the petitioner's right to a proceeding under Section 120.57, F.S., is waived.

(5) When there has been no publication of notice of agency action or notice of proposed agency action as prescribed in Rule 17-103.150, F.A.C., a person who has actual knowledge of the agency action or has knowledge which would lead a reasonable person to conclude that the Department has taken final agency action, has a duty to make further inquiry within 14 days of obtaining such knowledge by contacting the Department to ascertain whether action has occurred. The Department shall upon receipt of such an inquiry, if agency action has occurred, promptly provide the person with notice as prescribed by Rule 17-103.150, F.A.C. Failure of the person to make inquiry with the Department within 14 days after obtaining such knowledge may stop the person from obtaining an administrative proceeding on the agency action.

(6)(a) "Receipt of notice of agency action" means receipt of written notice of final agency action, as prescribed by Department rule, or the publication, pursuant to Department rule, of notice of final agency action, whichever first occurs.

(b) "Receipt of notice of proposed agency action" means receipt of written notice (such as a letter of intent) that the Department proposes to take certain action, or the publication pursuant to Department rule of notice of proposed agency action, whichever first occurs.

(7) Notwithstanding any other provision in this Chapter, should a substantially affected person who fails to timely request a hearing under Section 120.57, F.S., administratively appeal the final Department action or order, the record on appeal shall be limited to:

(a) the application and accompanying documentation submitted by the applicant prior to the issuance of the agency's intent to issue or deny the requested permit;

(b) the materials and information relied upon by the agency in determining the final agency action or order;

(c) any notices issued or published; and

(d) the final agency action or order entered concerning the permit application.

(8) In such cases where persons do not timely exercise their rights accorded by Section 120.57(1), Florida Statutes, the allegations of fact contained in or incorporated by the final agency action shall be deemed uncontested and true, and appellants may not dispute the truth of such allegations upon subsequent appeal.

(9) Any applicant may challenge the Department's request for additional information by filing with the Office of General Counsel an appropriate petition for administrative proceeding pursuant to Section 120.60, F.S., following receipt by the applicant of the Department's notification pursuant to Section 403.0876, F.S., that additional information is required.





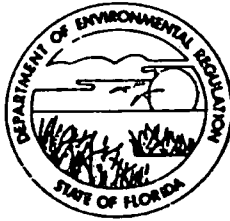

1. The terms, conditions, requirements, limitations, and restrictions set forth herein are "Permit Conditions" and as such are binding upon the permittee and enforceable pursuant to the authority of Sections 403.161, 403.727, or 403.859 through 403.861, Florida Statutes. The permittee is hereby placed on notice that the department will review this permit periodically and may initiate the enforcement action for any violation of the "Permit Conditions" by the permittee, its agent, employees, servants or representatives.

2. This permit is valid only for the specific processes and operations applied for and indicated in the approved drawings or exhibits. Any unauthorized deviation from the approved drawings, exhibits, specifications, or conditions of this permit may constitute grounds for revocation and enforcement action by the department.

3. As provided in Subsections 403.087(6) and 403.722(5), Florida Statutes, the issuance of this permit does not convey any vested rights or any exclusive privileges. Nor does it authorize any injury to public or private property or any invasion of personal rights, nor any infringement of federal, state or local laws or regulations. This permit does not constitute a waiver of or approval of any other department permit that may be required for other aspects of the total project which are not addressed in the permit.

4. This permit conveys no title to land or water, does not constitute state recognition or acknowledgement of title, and does not constitute authority for the use of submerged lands unless herein provided and the necessary title or leasehold interests have been obtained from the state. INTENT TO ISSUE

The Department of Environmental Regulation hereby gives notice of its Intent to Issue a construction permit (copy attached) for the proposed project as detailed in the application specified above. The Division is issuing this Intent of Issue for the reasons stated below.

The applicant, Mr. Samuel L. Rawls, Hardee County Board of County Commissioners, applied on March 11, 1988, to the Department of Environmental Regulation for a permit to construct a solid waste volume reduction facility (approximately 10 acres), referred to as Hardee County Class III Volume Reduction Facility, subject to the specific conditions attached, storing and incinerating solid waste, near Airport Road and S.R. 64A, northeast of Wauchula, Hardee County, Florida.

The Department has permitting jurisdiction under 403.861, Florida Statutes, and Rules 17-4.07, 17-7.030, and 17-7.090, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.). The project is not exempt from permitting procedures. The Department has determined that a construction permit is required for the proposed work.

The Department intends to issue this permit based on its belief that reasonable assurances have been provided to indicate that the proposed project will not adversely impact water quality and the proposed project will comply with the appropriate provisions of Chapters 17-3, 17-4, 17-7, and 17-25, subject to the specific conditions attached in the permit.

Pursuant to Section 403.815, F.S. and DER Rule 17-103.150, F.A.C., you (the applicant) are required to publish at your own expense the enclosed Notice of Proposed Agency Action on permit application. The notice must be published one time only in a section of a major local newspaper of general circulation in the county in which the project is located and within thirty (30) days from receipt of this intent. 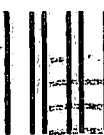
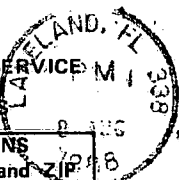

The Department gives notice of its intent issue a permit to Mr. Samuel L. Rawls, Hardee County Board of County Commissioners to construct a solid waste volume reduction facility (approximately 10 acres), referred to as Hardee County Class III Volume Reduction Facility, subject to the specific conditions attached, storing and incinerating solid waste, near Airport Road and S.R. 64A, northeast of Wauchula, Hardee County, Florida.

Persons whose substantial interests are affected by the Department's proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrative proceeding (hearing) in accordance with Section 120.57, Florida Statutes. The petition must conform to the requirements of Chapters 17-103 and 28-5, Florida Administrative Code, and must be filed (received) in the Office of General Counsel of the Department at 2600 Blair Stone Road, Twin Towers Office Building, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-2400, within fourteen (14) days of publication of this notice. 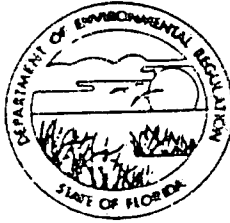

1. This facility and site is classified as a solid waste volume reduction facility, and shall be constructed and operated in accordance with all applicable requirements of Chapters 17-2, 17-3, 17-4, 17-7 and 17-25, Florida Administrative Code.
2. The facility shall be constructed in accordance with plans and information submitted July 5, 1988, by Aim Engineering, and information submitted July 6, 1988, by Hardee County Public Works Department, and in accordance with all applicable requirements of Department rules.
3. The facility shall have a surface water management system designed, constructed, operated, and maintained to prevent surface water flow onto storage areas, and a stormwater runoff control system designed, constructed, operated, and maintained to collect and control stormwater to meet requirements of Florida Administrative Code Rule 17-25, and requirements of the respective water management district. The facility owner or operator shall design and construct these systems within 180 days following issuance of this permit. The facility owner or operator should receive approvals of the design as necessary prior to construction of systems. After construction has been completed, the engineer or authorized public officer shall complete a Certification of Construction Completion, Department Form 17-7.130(2). "As-Built" drawings should be submitted to the Department.

1. The terms, conditions, requirements, limitations, and restrictions set forth herein are "Permit Conditions" and as such are binding upon the permittee and enforceable pursuant to the authority of Sections 403.161, 403.727, or 403.859 through 403.861, Florida Statutes. The permittee is hereby placed on notice that the department will review this permit periodically and may initiate the enforcement action for any violation of the "Permit Conditions" by the permittee, its agent, employees, servants or representatives.
2. This permit is valid only for the specific processes and operations applied for and indicated in the approved drawings or exhibits. Any unauthorized deviation from the approved drawings, exhibits, specifications, or conditions of this permit may constitute grounds for revocation and enforcement action by the department.
3. As provided in Subsections 403.087(6) and 403.722(5), Florida Statutes, the issuance of this permit does not convey any vested rights or any exclusive privileges. Nor does it authorize any injury to public or private property or any invasion of personal rights, nor any infringement of federal, state or local laws or regulations. This permit does not constitute a waiver of or approval of any other department permit that may be required for other aspects of the total project which are not addressed in the permit.
4. This permit conveys no title to land or water, does not constitute state recognition or acknowledgement of title, and does not constitute authority for the use of submerged lands unless herein provided and the necessary title or leasehold interests have been obtained from the state. Only the Trustees of the Internal Improvement Trust Fund may express state opinion as to title.
5. This permit does not relieve the permittee from liability for harm or injury to human health or welfare, animal, plant or aquatic life or property and penalties therefore caused by the construction or operation of this permitted source, nor does it allow the permittee to cause pollution in contravention of Florida Statutes and department rules, unless specifically authorized by any order from the department.
6. The permittee shall at all times properly operate and maintain the facility and systems of treatment and control (and related appurtenances) that are installed or used by the permittee to achieve compliance with the conditions of this permit, as required by department rules. This provision includes the operation of backup or auxiliary facilities or similar systems when necessary to achieve compliance with the conditions of the permit and when required by department rules.
7. Reasonable time may depend on the nature of the concern being investigated.

8. If, for any reason, the permittee does not comply with or will be unable to comply with any condition or limitation specified in this permit, the permittee shall immediately notify and provide the department with the following information:

- (a) a description of and cause of non-compliance; and
- (b) the period of non-compliance, including exact dates and times; or, if not corrected, the anticipated time the non-compliance is expected to continue, and steps being taken to reduce, eliminate, and prevent recurrence of the non-compliance.

The permittee shall be responsible for any and all damages which may result and may be subject to enforcement action by the department for penalties or revocation of this permit.

9. In accepting this permit, the permittee understands and agrees that all records, notes, monitoring data and other information relating to the construction or operation of this permitted source, which are submitted to the department, may be used by the department as evidence in any enforcement case arising under the Florida Statutes or department rules, except where such use is prescribed by Sections 403.73 and 403.111, Florida Statutes.

10. The permittee agrees to comply with changes in department rules and Florida Statutes after a reasonable time for compliance, provided, however, the permittee does not waive any other rights granted by Florida Statutes or department rules.

11. This permit is transferable only upon department approval in accordance with Florida Administrative Code Rules 17-4.12 and 17-30.30, as applicable. The permittee shall be liable for any non-compliance of the permitted activity until the transfer is approved by the department.

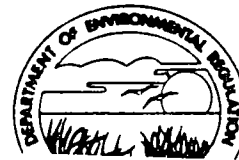

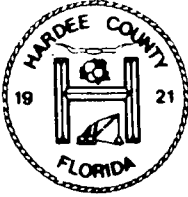

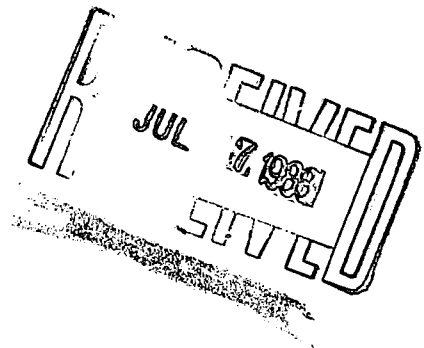

INTRODUCTION:

The purpose of this Operation Plan is to provide a written description of the daily operation of the Class III Landfill.

A. Designation of Responsible Persons:

A Solid Waste Superintendent has been assigned by the Board of County Commissioners over the operation of the landfill. Commissioner Maurice Henderson was appointed to be the liaison Commissioner for the Landfill. A Senior Operator is designated as being in charge of the site. The Solid Waste Superintendent directs the Senior Operator where the waste is to be place.

B. Contingency Operations:

The landfill has one dozier, one front end loader, one dragline and a diesel pump. This equipment is currently used on the Class I Landfill located on the same 96 acre site as the Class III Landfill. This equipment would be used for both operations. In addition, equipment from Hardee County Public Works, Road and Bridge Department, may be loaned to the Solid Waste Division for the use during an emergency.

C. Controlling the type of waste received:

The gate attendant will stop all vehicles entering the Landfill and determine if the material is suitable for the Class III Landfill. If material is determined to be suitable for burning the person will be directed to the storage site at the Class III Landfill. The type of material to be received at the Class III will be clean, burnable wood products consisting of land clearing debris, Tree Surgeon's debris, and yard trash. Including, but not limited to clean wood debris such as untreated lumber or pallets.

D. Measuring Waste:

All vehicles transporting waste to the Landfill are required to stop at the Gate House to sign in. The Gate Attendant makes a visual check of the amount and estimates the cubic yards, of wood products entering the Class III site.

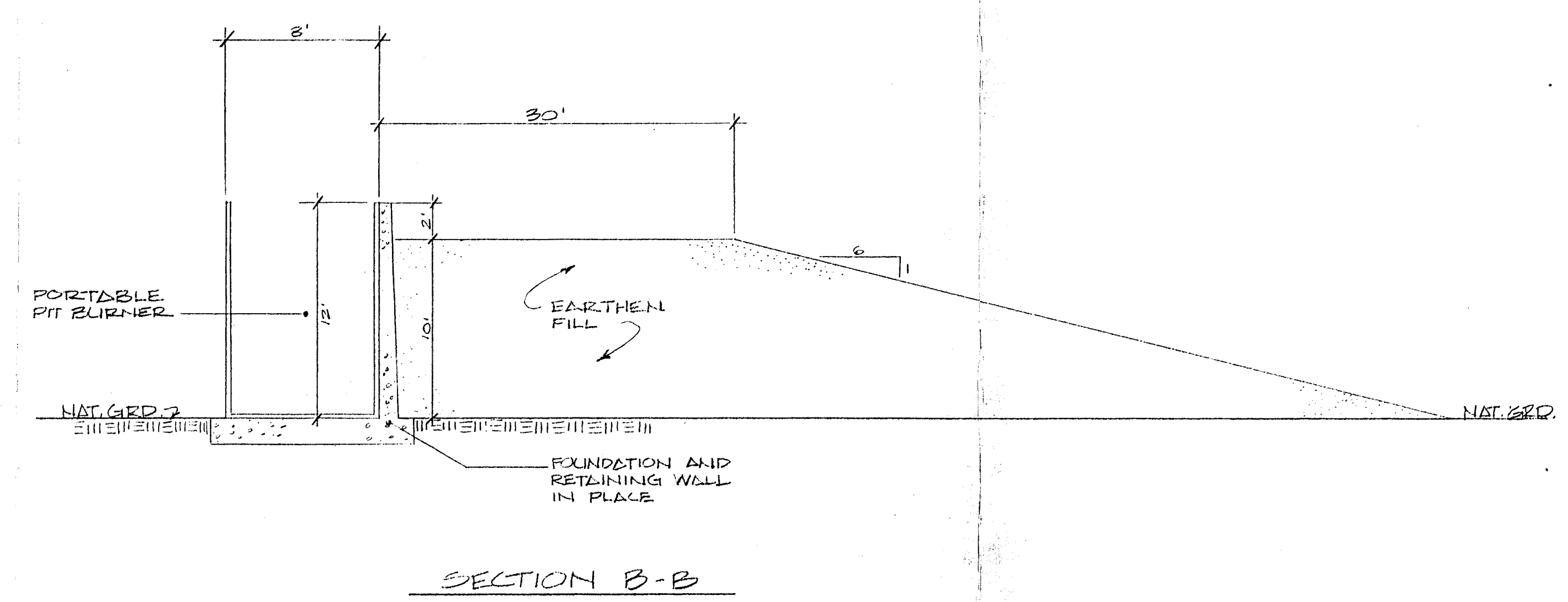
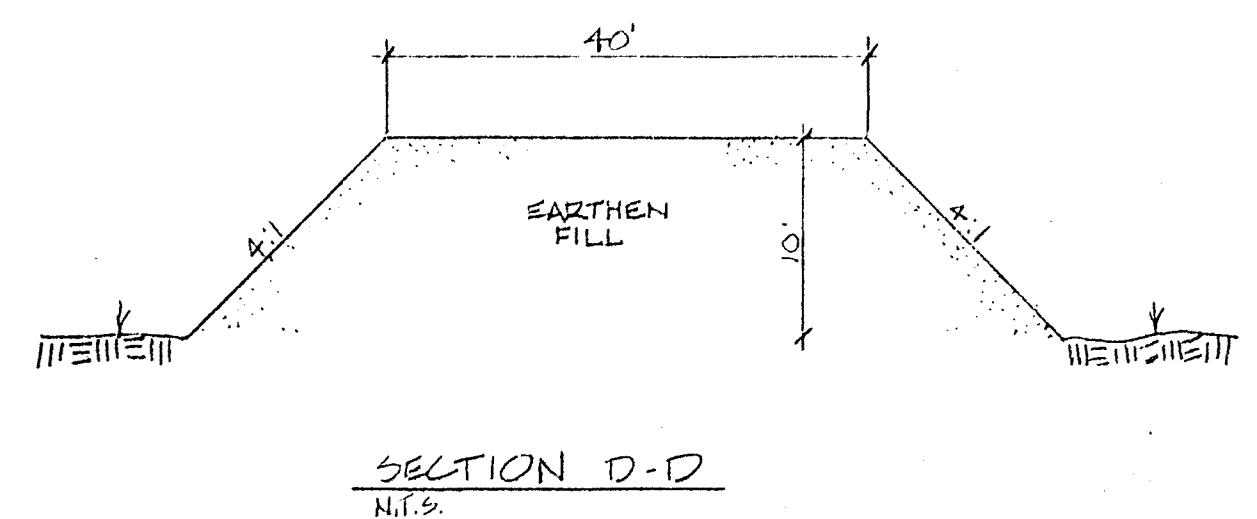
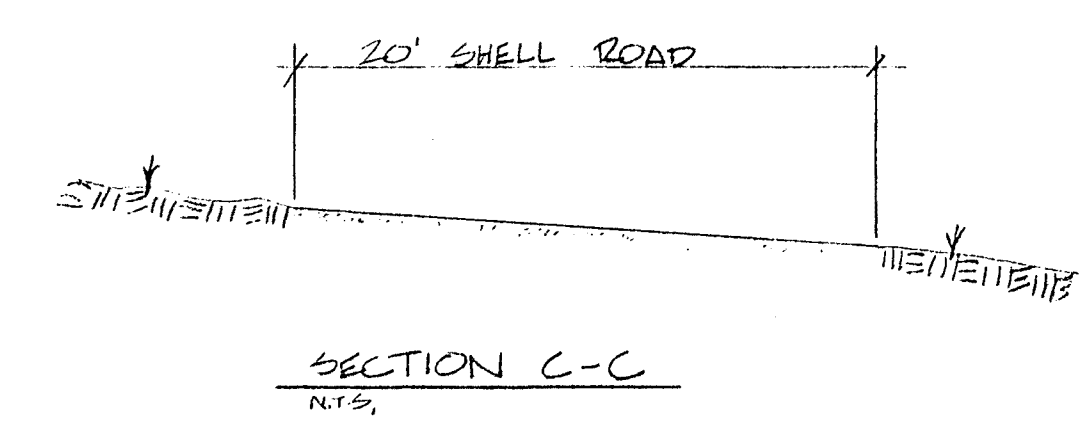
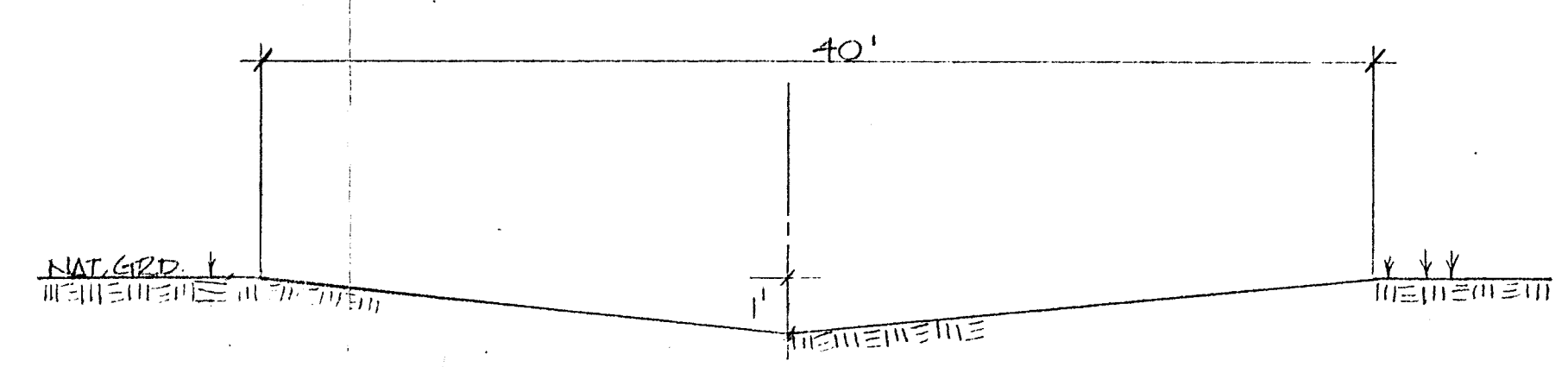
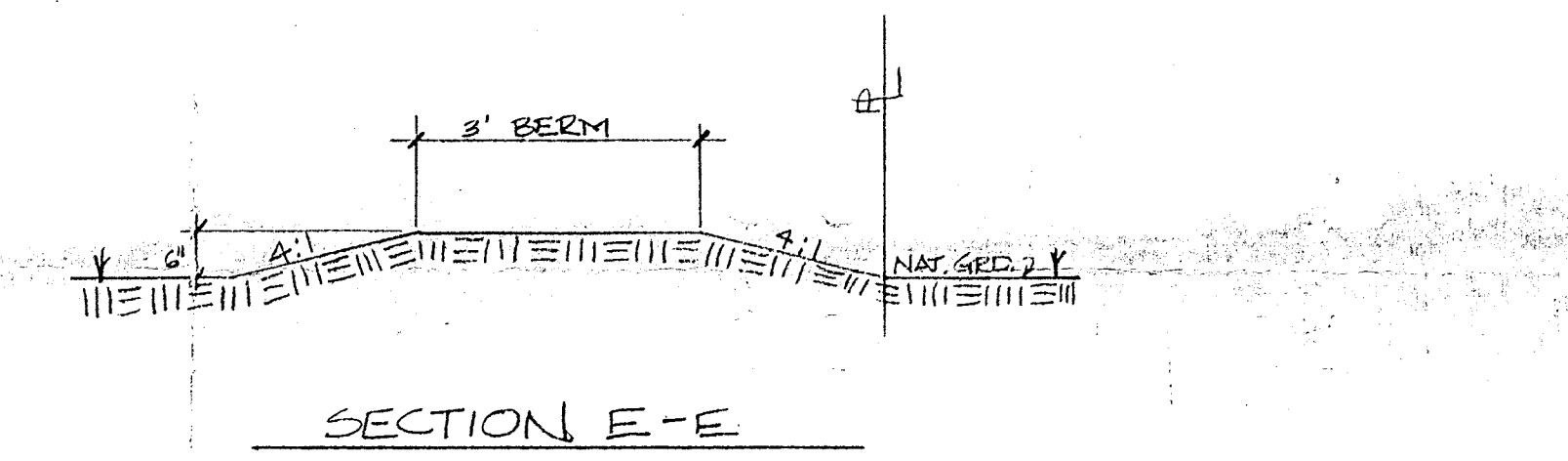
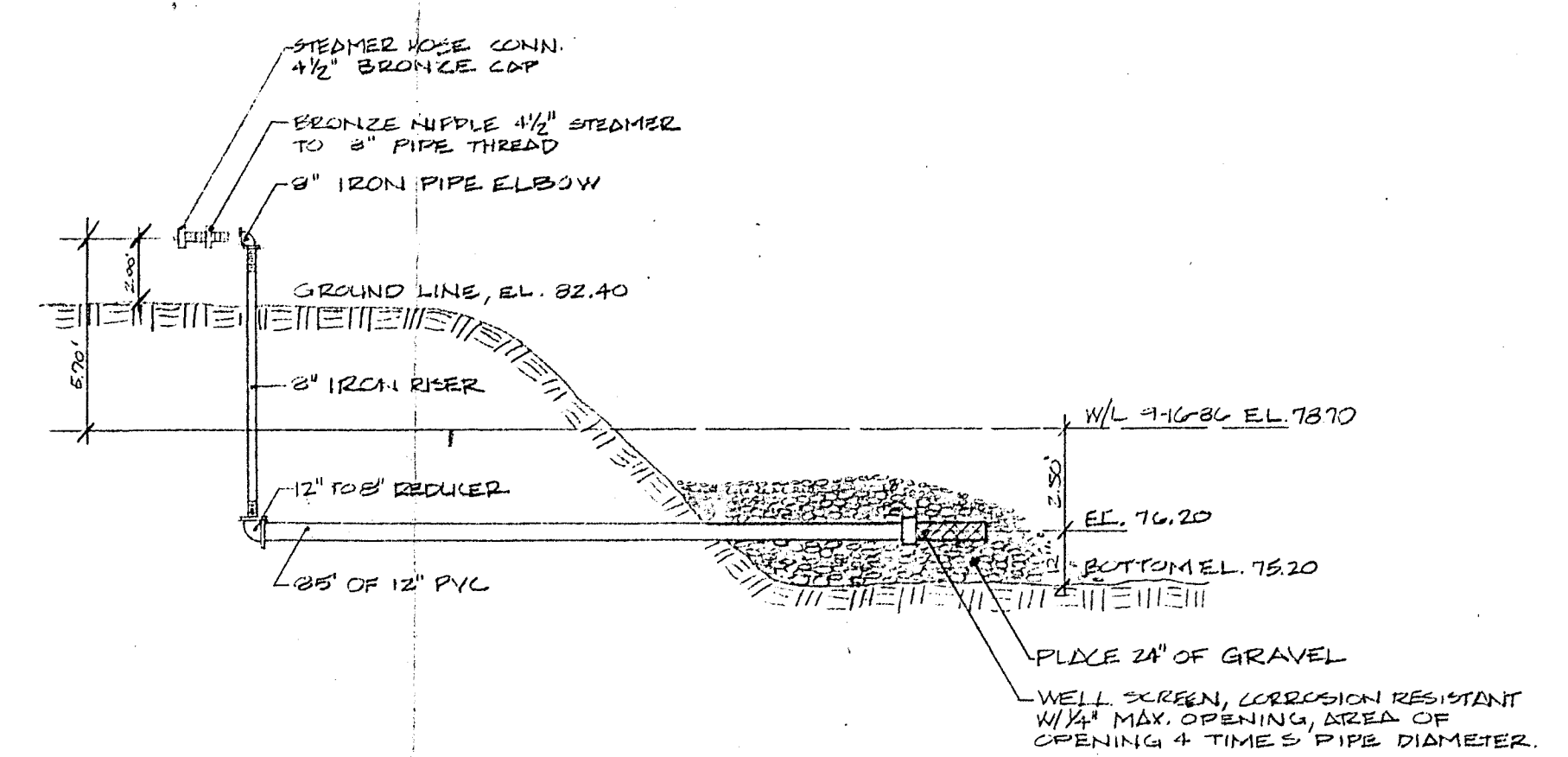
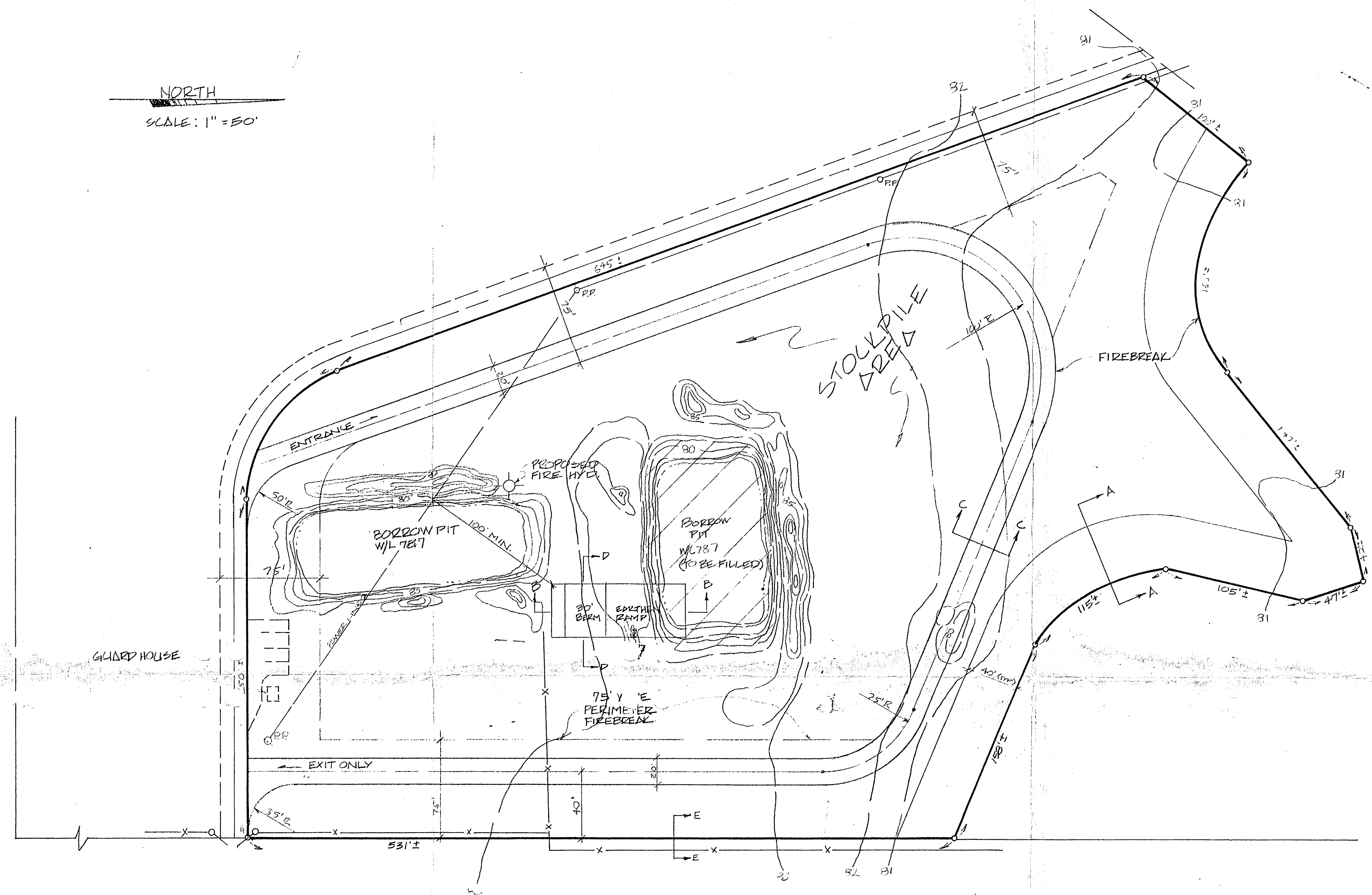
E. Storage Site:

The landclearing debris, yard trash , and other wood products will be piled and stored at the end of each day, for a period of time not to exceed 11 months, or until such volume indicates a need for disposal. Fire break will be kept clean of burnable material.

F. Volume Reduction Incineration Operation:

At the end of a 11 month period of storage, the County will negotiate a contract, with a firm, for a portable Air Curtain Incinerator to burn the wood. Incineration services shall be on a intern basis, to be determined by the volume of debris available for disposal, as mutually agreed upon by the County and Contractor. Fee for this service, shall be based upon volume processed. The Air Curtain Incinerator must comply with all Florida Department of Environmental Regulation air quality standards. The ashes from the incinerator will be removed and placed in the Class I Landfill for disposal.

B.) Proposed Operation

Hardee County presently has an attendant on duty six days per week, ten and one-half hours per day. The entrance to the Class III facility will be controlled by a gate located adjacent to the attendants office. All waste will be checked prior to being allowed within the facility. All waste not segregated will be directed to the existing landfill. The Boundary of the Class III site is fenced and diked to prevent unauthorized access.

1.) Cover Material

Cover material will be dug and stockpiled on site from the existing pond areas with equipment shared with the existing landfill. Cover material will be placed in accordance with Chapter 17-7 F.A.C. after spreading and compaction of waste.

2.) Fire Control

The City of Wauchula Fire Department is located approximately three miles from this site with an estimated response time of three minutes. A dry fire hydrant will be installed at the pond as shown on the site plan to facilitate refilling of the fire equipment.

A.) Background

Hardee County presently operates a landfill located in Section 35, Township 33 South, Range 25 East and accepts all solid waste including yard trash and land clearing debris. The high cost of disposal, combined with the bulk of this type of waste makes it necessary and desirable to separate the yard trash from the remaining solid waste.

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B.) Proposed Operation

Hardee County presently has an attendant on duty six days per week, ten and one-half hours per day. The entrance to the Class III facility will be controlled by a gate located adjacent to the attendants office. All waste will be checked prior to being allowed within the facility. All waste not segregated will be directed to the existing landfill. The Boundary of the Class III site is fenced and diked to prevent unauthorized access.

1.) Cover Material

Cover material will be dug and stockpiled on site from the existing pond areas with equipment shared with the existing landfill. Cover material will be placed in accordance with Chapter 17-7 F.A.C. after spreading and compaction of waste.

2.) Fire Control

The City of Wauchula Fire Department is located approximately three miles from this site with an estimated response time of three minutes. A dry fire hydrant will be installed at the pond as shown on the site plan to facilitate refilling of the fire equipment.

A.) Background

Hardee County presently operates a landfill located in Section 35, Township 33 South, Range 25 East and accepts all solid waste including yard trash and land clearing debris. The high cost of disposal, combined with the bulk of this type of waste makes it necessary and desirable to separate the yard trash from the remaining solid waste.

Hardee County's present and projected population and projected yard trash generation are shown below.

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B.) Proposed Operation

Hardee County presently has an attendant on duty six days per week, ten and one-half hours per day. The entrance to the Class III facility will be controlled by a gate located adjacent to the attendants office. All waste will be checked prior to being allowed within the facility. All waste not segregated will be directed to the existing landfill. The Boundary of the Class III site is fenced and diked to prevent unauthorized access.

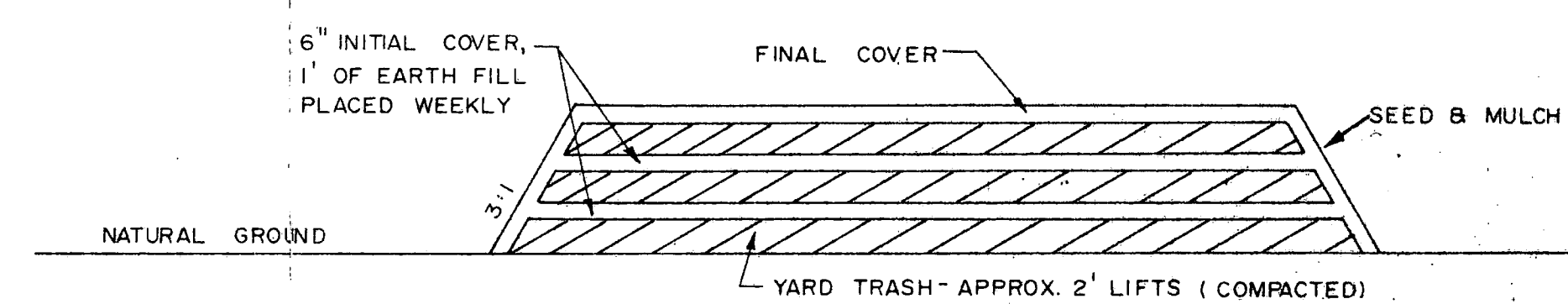
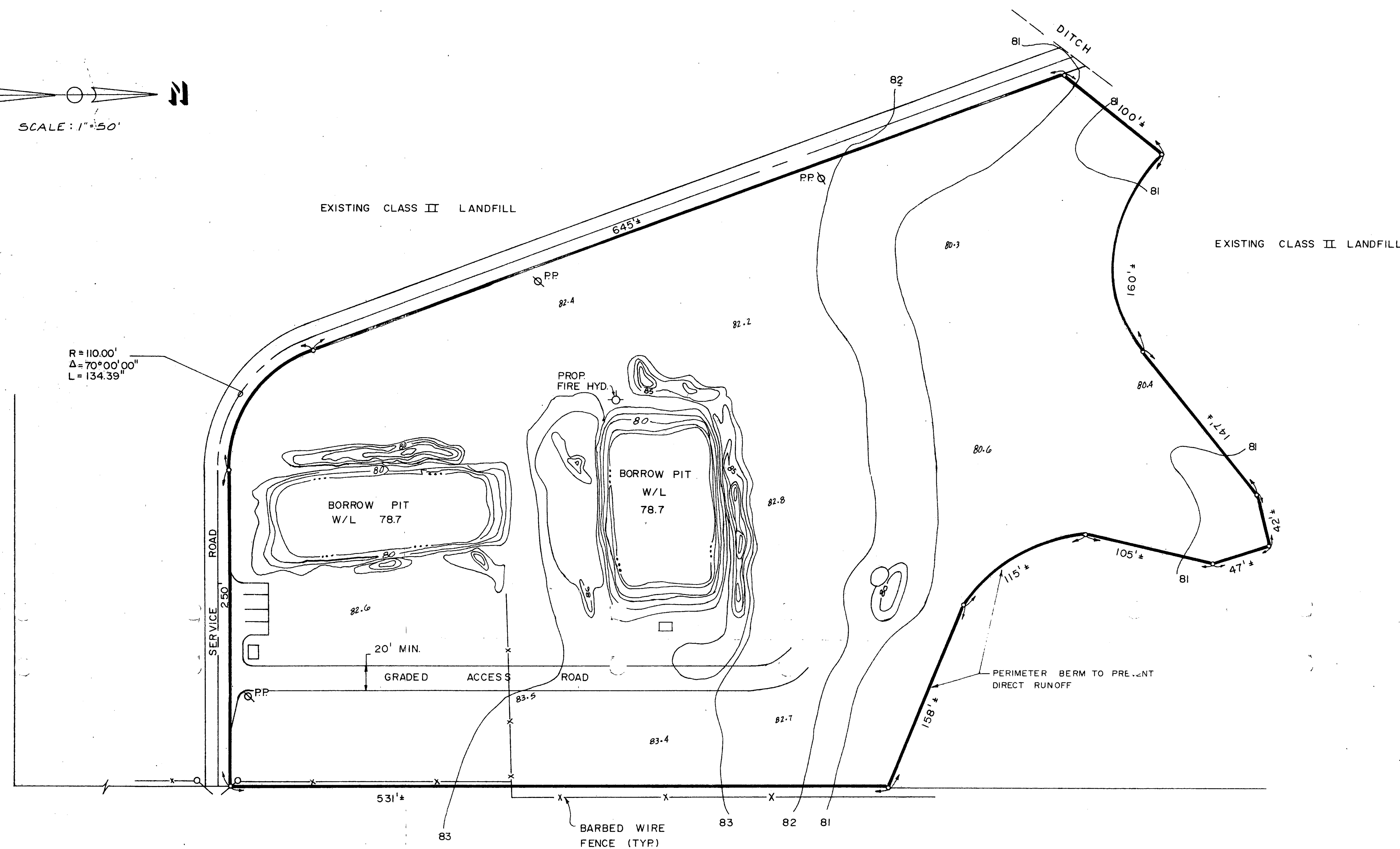
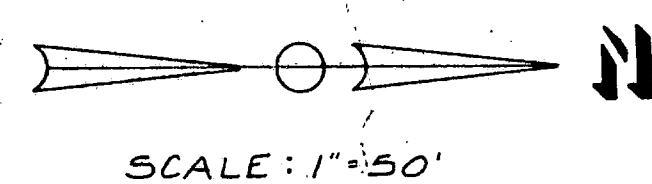
1.) Cover Material

Cover material will be dug and stockpiled on site from the existing pond areas with equipment shared with the existing landfill. Cover material will be placed in accordance with Chapter 17-7 F.A.C. after spreading and compaction of waste.

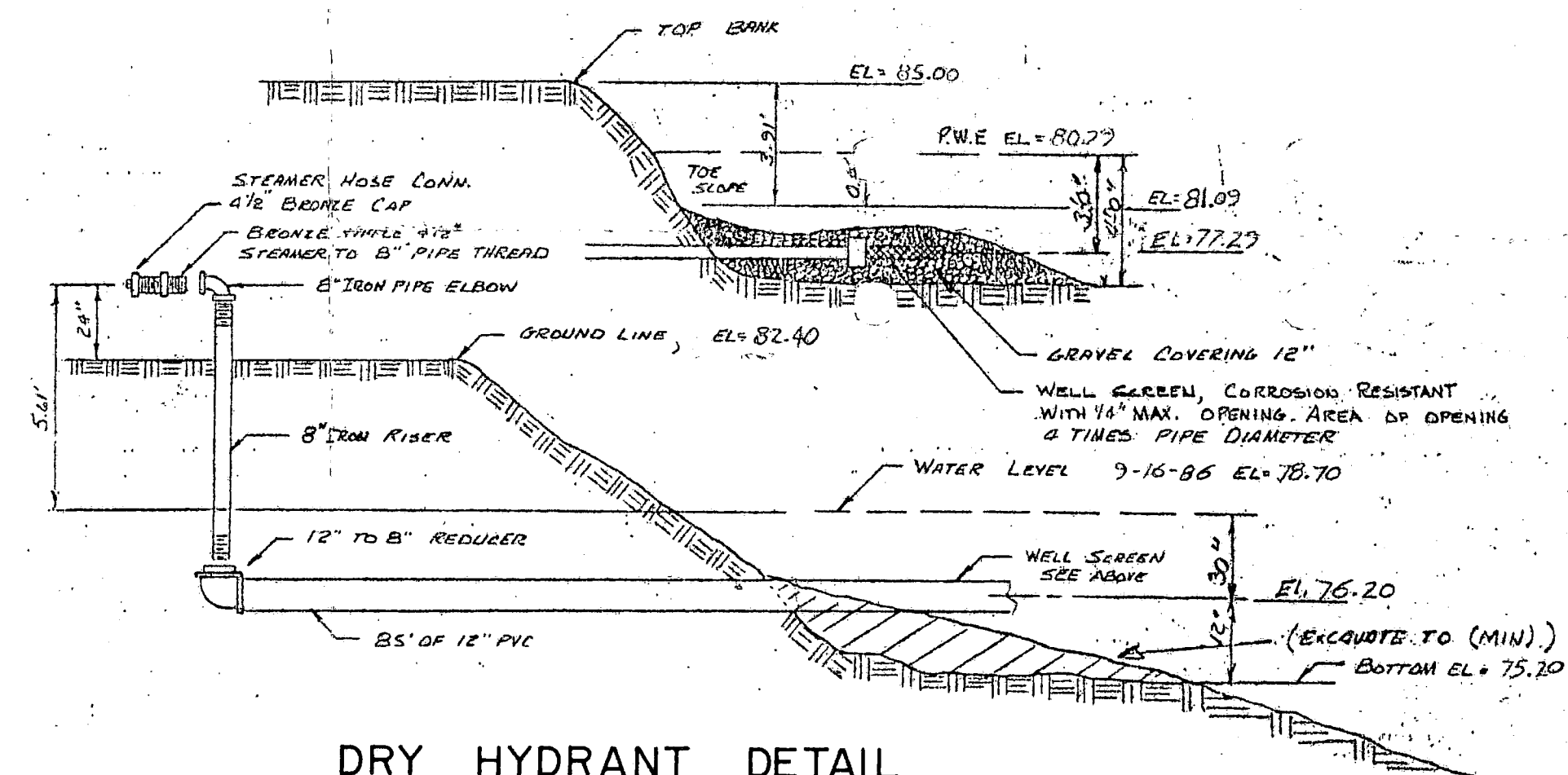
2.) Fire Control

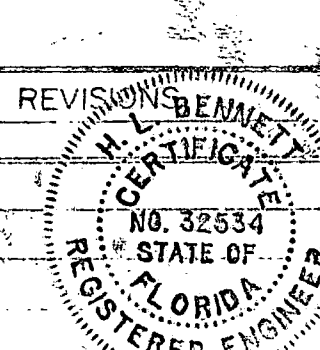
