Joe:

The notice sent by Tallahassee to our solid waste permittees was focused on getting analytical results for monitoring events (ground water, surface water, leachate) prepared as an electronic data deliverable (EDDs) that is compatible with the ADaPT format. The water elevations measured at monitor wells and staff gauges associated with these routine monitor events should be included as part of the EDD.

We are not looking for the data associated with the monthly measurement of water levels on both sides of the slurry wall to demonstrate an inward hydraulic gradient has been maintained at Lena Road landfill to be prepared in an ADaPT format. The normal way that the water level data has been submitted (comparing the elevations on either side of the slurry wall at each of the gradient monitoring pairs) does not need to be revised.

Subject: Glass Collet

Good morning Nancy,

I spoke to you on the phone about stockpiling glass collet (chipped glass), a by product from Strategic Materials, Inc., that we are interested in using for road building material inside the landfill footprint. We are always looking for ways to cut our costs to compensate for our declining landfill tonnages . This appears to be a good use for this material instead of using a natural resource such as washed or bank run shell, and we could recover this material for reuse whenever we are changing our haul road locations. This would offset the cost of shell and crushed concrete that average between \$19.00 to \$21.00 a ton. The samples of this material that were brought in were clean in nature (glass , clay, and very little to no paper still attached). Strategic Materials has obtained a new machine that removes the plastics, thus the appearance of this material has greatly improved. Mike Gore informed me that this material has been used at the Strategic Materials facility for parking and driveways for an estimated twenty years. Because of the footprint we are working in at our landfill, our space is limited so we are asking to store this material in Stage 2 along with the crushed concrete and shell that is currently located there. Tom Burns, Area Manager for Strategic Materials, mentioned that a couple of DEP officials, Cindy Falandysz and Robert Soptei, were familiar with his sight and that he worked with them through his permitting process.

I look forward to hearing you about this request.

Good morning Nancy, I wanted to inform Susan and yourself of our next excavation per our recent conversation. It is our plan to begin excavating Phases 3 and 4 on August 31, 2009, we feel this is as far through rainy season as we dare wait. For your knowledge we estimate the excavation will require fourteen weeks to complete inclusive of submitting the registered survey, pictures, and the Certificate of Construction Completion. It is our goal to have your office everything mentioned and required by November 27, 2009.
