This letter report is being submitted to the Department to satisfy the requirements of Rule 62-701.500(13)(c), F.A.C.:

Maintain an annual estimate of the remaining life and capacity in cubic yards of the existing, constructed landfill and an annual estimate of the life and capacity in cubic yards of other permitted areas not yet constructed. The estimate shall be made and reported annually to the Department.

To date Cells 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 15 have been certified for use by the Department and collectively are accepting Class III materials. The remaining airspace of the operating landfill is estimated to be approximately 1,280,000 cubic yards (as of January 1, 2016), which could take approximately 2.75 years to fill.
