Dear Mr. Lubozynski:

On behalf of Waste Management Inc. of Florida (WMIF), SCS Engineers (SCS) has prepared the annual landfill life report for the remaining disposal life of the Vista Class III Landfill, operated by WMIF. This letter report has been prepared in accordance with Specific Condition C.14(b) of the facility's Solid Waste Permit No. 0165969-028-SO-T3 and Rule 62-701.500(13)(c), F.A.C. The remaining airspace and life values presented below are based on volumetric calculations between the most recent topographic map of the site dated January 6, 2017 (attached) and the permitted final grades.

The remaining net airspace for waste disposal within the permitted landfill footprint is approximately 6,938,700 yd³. Based on the compacted waste unit weight of 1,500 pcy (Airspace Utilization Factor of 0.75 tons/yd³), the remaining capacity of the Vista Class III Landfill is approximately 5,204,000 tons. Considering a waste flow rate of 230,000 tons per year, the remaining life of the landfill is approximately 23 years.

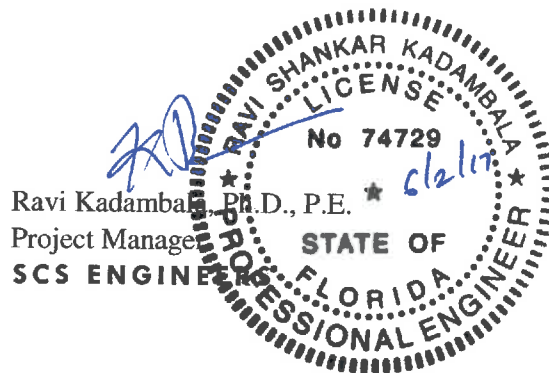
