300 tons @ \$100/ton = \$30,000 (or \$1.00/tire)

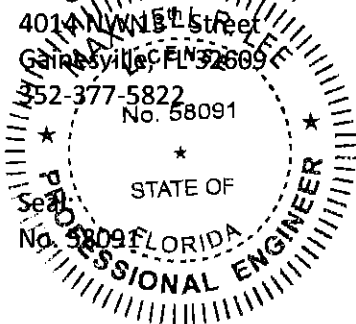
