This correspondence is to acknowledge receipt of the inflation-adjusted cost estimates, dated and received February 21, 2018, for closure of CEMEX Brooksville South Cement Plant Alternative Fuel Material Processing Facility. The cost estimates received February 21, 2018 (total for closing \$337,741.18) are **APPROVED for 2018**. The approved estimates are for a total of approximately 4900 tons of alternative fuel materials at the site at any time. The next update (revised estimates) is due no later than **August 8, 2018** with the upcoming permit renewal application.

The above referenced facility has experienced no changes the management of alternative fuels and is operating in compliance with the permit requirements. The maximum quantity of alternative fuel storage is 4,900 tons. The anticipated disposal cost for the maximum storage quantity is calculated as follows:

2017 Disposal Cost Estimate = \$333,406.89
FDEP Inflation Multiplier **2018** = 1.013
2018 Disposal Cost Estimate (1.009 x \$330,432.99) = \$337,741.18
Current Bond Amount - \$350,000, Travelers Bond No. 106077080
