The Environmental Protection Division (EPD) has received correspondence from you, dated February 28, 2018, on behalf of Taft Recycling, Inc., with revised cost estimates for closure of the above referenced facility. The revised estimates are based upon an inflation adjustment of 1.3 % applied to the previously approved cost estimate. The estimates are satisfactory. Therefore, the Orange County approved cost-estimates for the period of April 23, 2018 through February 28, 2019 are summarized below.

EPD acknowledges that "Taft Recycling, Inc." has elected to participate in the "Interlocal Agreement Relating to the Solid Waste Program Financial Assurance Mechanisms". This Agreement allows the owner or operator to provide a single financial assurance mechanism to cover the cost of closure to the benefit of both the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) and Orange County. Per the Interlocal Agreement, the financial assurance mechanism must cover the greater of the closure, and of the post-closure, cost estimates approved by the FDEP and Orange County.
