SUBJECT: ANNUAL FIRE SAFETY SURVEY

Dear Mr. Roudebush:

In accordance with Chapter 62-711.540.1.d.F.A.C. Waste Tire Rule, the Fire Safety Survey was performed on April 24, 2018.

Results of the survey are as follows:

- There are no activities involving the use of open flames being conducted within 25 feet of a waste tire pile.
- An emergency management plan is maintained on site, which contains the procedures to be followed in the event of a fire. This plan includes names and numbers of persons to be contacted in the event of fires, floods, or other emergencies. Adequate emergency response and communication equipment is available on site and locations are noted in the emergency plan.
- The site is bermed in order to ensure adequate protection to keep liquid runoff from a potential tire fire from entering water bodies.
- A 50-foot wide fire lane is maintained around the perimeter of the outdoor waste tire pile and access to the fire lane is unobstructed at all times.
- The site is paved and is kept free of grass and other potentially flammable vegetation.
