Hi Justin,

Thanks for taking my call. Per our discussion I would like to move the proposed monitoring well 4MW-23 outside the 50' discussed in the document referenced below to relocate the location of the well out of the storm water swale surrounding the perimeter of the landfill. We would keep the well within the 100' zone of discharge but would drill on the opposing side of the swale adjacent to the perimeter road. I have attached a few photos. The first is the 50' marker from the edge of liner, located in the swale and the second is 4MW-22 which is located adjacent from sub cells 1-2 in our class three and placed on the adjacent side of the storm water swale as we are proposing.
