This letter is to acknowledge receipt of inflation-adjusted cost estimates, dated and received February 7, 2019, for closure of the CEMEX South Cement Plant Waste Tire Processing Facility. The cost estimates received February 7, 2019 (total for closing \$38,175.00) are **APPROVED for 2019**. This estimate is for disposal of 300 tons of waste tires. The next annual cost estimate is due at least 60 days prior to anniversary of the financial assurance mechanism. The above referenced facility has experienced no changes the management of waste tires and is operating in compliance with the permit requirements. The maximum quantity of tires allowed to be stored on site is 300 tons. The anticipated disposal cost for the maximum storage quantity is calculated as follows:

2018 Disposal Cost Estimate = \$37,500.00
FDEP Inflation Multiplier **2019 = 1.018**
2019 Disposal Cost Estimate (1.018 x \$35,211.47) = \$38,175.00
Current Bond Amount - \$58,440.00, Travelers Bond No. 105316798
