It is the Department's desire to provide prompt turnaround times on permit applications, and a quicker response to this RAI shortens the timeframe for which a final decision on the application can be made. Pursuant to Rule 62-4.055(1), Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.) and Section 120.60, Florida Statute, failure of an applicant to provide timely requested information by the applicant deadline may result in denial of the application. 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1. Please have a Professional Engineer, registered in the State of Florida, sign and seal the application form, and supporting documentation, then resubmit to Northeast District Waste Program staff.
2. Please completely fill out application form's Part II.E. and Part II.F., and resubmit the completed form to Northeast District staff.
3. Please submit a Site Plan with locations of waste tire storage areas, loading area, sorting areas, and processing areas clearly identified the following information as required by Application Form Part III.A. Please note, if a response will indicate "No Change," it should specify when the information was previously provided, identify list the document in which it is located by title, date, and date of submittal. Also, specify the location of the referenced material within that document.
4. In accordance with Application Form Part III.B. requirements, please submit a "Facility Operation" plan that adequately summarizes and accurately reflects Rules 62-711.530 and 62-711.540, F.A.C. Also, please include a copy of the emergency preparedness manual for the Facility and a copy of the fire safety survey.
5. Please recalculate and provide revised closing cost estimates quotes to Northeast District staff. Rule 62-701.630(4)(b), F.A.C., "At the time of permit renewal, or every fifth year when a permit is issued with a duration greater than 5 years, the owner or operator shall revise the cost estimate. Revisions shall be made by recalculating the total cost of closure or long-term care, in current dollars, as specified in subsection (3) of this section." Also, Rule 62-711.500(3), F.A.C., "Owners or operators of waste tire sites shall provide closing cost estimates for the quantity of waste tires on their site or the quantity of waste tires that they are permitted to have on their site, whichever is greater. The cost estimate shall be the amount that would be expended to remove, process, and dispose of waste tires on the site and to close the site. The costs shall be based on a third party, who is not a subsidiary or parent company, performing the work, reported on a per unit basis."
