Dear Mr. Arnold:

This letter is to acknowledge receipt of inflation-adjusted cost estimates, dated and received March 13, 2019, for closure of the Enterprise Road Recycling & Disposal Waste Tire Facility. The cost estimates received March 13, 2019 (total for closing \$146,935.30) are **APPROVED for 2019**. This estimate is for disposal of 2,028 tons of waste tires at the site at any time. The next annual update (revised or inflation-adjusted estimates) is due no later than **March 1, 2020**.


