DEP received your submittal dated June 13, 2019, regarding the five year sumbittal for Trail Ridge Landfill (WACs ID 33628) per Specific condition Section 2.A.5 and have the following comments:

Both the cover letter to the August 25, 2017 cost estimates and Section 2 of the August 25, 2017 document (included with the submttal), indicate the cost estimates are based on 2015 unit cost. However, pursuant to permit specific condition A.5.b. of Section 2, of permit 0013493-026-SC-01 and Rule 62-701.630(4)(b), F.A.C, the estimates are to be recalculated based on current dollars. Therefore, provide recalculated cost estimates in current dollars (Year 2019), that are for a third party performing the work, on a per unit basis, with the source of estimates indicated, pursuant to Rule 62-701.630(3)(a), F.A.C. The cost estimates are to be signed and sealed by a professional engineer. As a side note, the cost estimates provided which are dated September 2018, appear to not be the last approved cost estimates. Per DEP's letter of October 16, 2018 the last approved cost estimates were dated October 15, 2018, and were inflation adjusted.
