Thank you for your Permit Renewal Application to continue to operate the Advanced Tire Recycling, Inc., Waste Tire Processing Facility submitted on January 24, 2020. Pursuant to Rule 62-4.055(1), Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.) and Section 120.60, Florida Statute, failure of an applicant to provide timely requested information by the applicant deadline may result in denial of the application. 2. The Facility is incorrectly identified as being located at, "2203 HAMILTON STREET JACKONVILLE. FL 32210" on the Land Use Map. Please revise the Land Use Map reflecting the correct address and resubmit.
3. Please revise the site plans and operations plan to include a reference and clarification for a berm to be located around the 13,570 sq ft trailer storage area referenced in section C., your application. According to Rule 62-711.540(3)(e), F.A.C., all outdoor waste tires storage, including the tires in 53' trailers, shall be bermed or given other adequate protection if necessary to keep liquid runoff from a potential waste tire fire from entering water bodies.
