Good morning Glen:

Thank you for notifying the Department of the Respondent's choice to implement an in-kind project. I would like to reiterate some requirements outlined in Exhibit A of this Consent Order regarding the deadlines associated with the in-kind project proposal. First, a detailed in-kind project proposal must be submitted to the Department for evaluation by no later than September 12, 2020. The costs documented in this in-kind proposal shall not include those incurred in developing the proposal and obtaining approval for the in-kind project. Labor costs shall not be included as well. Second, approval of an in-kind project must be obtained by no later than November 11, 2020. If the approval of an in-kind project is not obtained by this date, then the civil penalties detailed in the Consent Order must be paid within 30 days of Department notice.
