Explanation:

11/16/2020: Upon arrival, I met with Mr. Lou Webber and he showed me the area. Apparently, a dump truck full of large shredded tires got stuck in the grass. In order to reduce the weight of the truck, the 8 tons of shredded tired were dumped on the ground. Mr. Webber then decided to use the shredded tires as a road base for future parking.

11/23/2020: Per an e-mail exchange with Officer David Terrones (FDEP), he received a call from JSO about Lou Webber Tire and wondered if I was there recently as JSO was wanting to know whether the guy was lying to them or not. I responded to Officer Terrones that I did in fact inspect the facility and he is within his 30 days to remediate the issue. Later the same day, I heard from Helen Gainey (City of Jax) about the shredded tires as the complaint had been referred to JSO and Municipal Code Enforcement.

11/30/2020: I called the facility and was informed that Mr. Webber is out of town until Wednesday (December 2, 2020), but he did call in to the office earlier this morning and indicated that he would get started on this on Wednesday. I left my phone number for him and asked that if they spoke with him again, to have him call me. I also sent an e-mail update to Mrs. Gainey, Officer Terrones & Jeff Schroer.

Corrective Action: 11/16/2020: I instructed Mr. Webber that leaving the waste tire shreds in place without a permit was a violation of Chapter 62-701. As such I gave Mr. Webber 30 days to remove the waste tire shreds and submit photos and a disposal receipt to the Department. Mr. Webber agreed.

12/2/2020: Per a discussion with Mr. Webber, he is in the process of getting the waste tire shreds removed and asked if he could place mulch in the disturbed area to keep it clean. After a discussion with Jeff Schroer, this was approved. I relayed this information to Mr. Webber and requested photos and a copy of the disposal manifest be submitted to the Department.

12/7/2020: Per a discussion with an employee, the waste tire shreds are removed and they are waiting on mulch. I left work for Mr. Webber to e-mail me photos and a manifest.

12/15/2020: Receive photos from facility confirming the waste tire shreds were removed and placed in a dumpster for disposal.

1/13/2021: Receive waste disposal receipt of waste tire shreds, resolving this complaint.
