<u>Permit Type</u>: Initial operation permit for a new WTPF – WT/02

Permit Summary: The facility includes a paved outdoor storage area for whole waste tires measuring 2,500 square feet. A scale is located at the facility to weigh both inbound whole tires and outbound shredded tires. The maximum quantity of whole tires to be stored at the facility is 80 tons. Whole waste tires are processed onsite using feed conveyors with an outside shredder. The shredder is a "primary" shredder designed to cut rubber tires to 3-inch width pieces with length varying 3-inch to 9-inch and with di minimis residuals (less than 1%). The shredder has a throughput range of 15 to 20 tons per hour (TPH). All of the shredder's processed discharge materials will be conveyed directly into the hauling vehicles which will transport the processed tires

for disposal at a permitted solid waste management facility. The maximum quantity of processed tires to be stored at the facility is 40 tons.
