The Florida Department of Environmental Protection (Department) has reviewed the following document submitted pursuant to Florida Administrative Code Chapters 62-4 and 62-711 to Use a General Permit for a Waste Tire Mobile Shredding, as provided in Rule 62-711.801, F.A.C.:

Document 1 – *Waste Tire General Permit Application*, prepared by Sasha Yang of Webber Recycling, LLC, dated June 8, 2021 and received on July 1, 2021.

Based upon review of the notification and supporting documentation, the Department does not object to your use of the 1-year General Permit for the Webber Recycling Waste Tire Mobile Shredding at the Trail Ridge Landfill (WACS #33628).
