According to Department records, the permit to operate the US 27 Tires Waste Tire Processing Facility, Permit No. 369009-001-WT/02, will expire on **January 31, 2022** unless an application for permit extension is submitted to the Department by **January 1, 2022** in accordance with Permit Specific Condition 2.A.4.

In order to extend the permit up to five years from the original date of permit issuance, the following information should be submitted to the Department by **January 1, 2022**:

- Submit documentation of a renewed/extended lease issued to US 27 Tires, LLC for the property on which the facility is currently located; and
- Submit a request for a permit time extension and a \$50 application fee, signed by the permittee.

A minimum of one electronic copy of the application and all supporting information for the time extension application shall be provided to the Air and Solid Waste Permitting Manager, Mr. Steve Morgan, <a href="Steve.Morgan@FloridaDEP.gov">Steve.Morgan@FloridaDEP.gov</a>, with a copy to assigned processor, Ms. Emily Stitt, <a href="Emily.Stitt@FloridaDEP.gov">Emily.Stitt@FloridaDEP.gov</a>. You may also mail a paper copy of the completed application and a check for the permit application fee to the Florida Department of Environmental Protection, Attention: Air & Solid Waste Permitting Manager, Southwest District Office, at 13051 N. Telecom Parkway, Suite 101, Temple Terrace, Florida 33637. Alternatively, the applicant may make an online payment of the fee following submittal of the permit application. Notification of receipt of the application and instructions regarding online payment will be provided at that time.
