L Remarks E23 was dispatched to the area of the landfill reference possible fire. E23 responded to station from Hwy 41/Hwy 44 to pick up brush truck. E23 and B23 responded to the area of the landfill. Both units were able to make access to the landfill through the front gate by utilizing the knox box. B23 found a large rubbish/trash fire, approximately 25'x50' in size upon arrival. E23 notified BC2 and asked dispatch to tone Rescue 7 to pick up Twr 1 and bring to the incident. Engine 23 set up water supply and supplied the tower for extinguishment operations. Landfill staff arrived on scene and were able to assist in moving the trash around for proper extinguishment. In total, 50,000 gallons of water were used. E23 terminated command and released all units on scene. E23 completed assignment available.

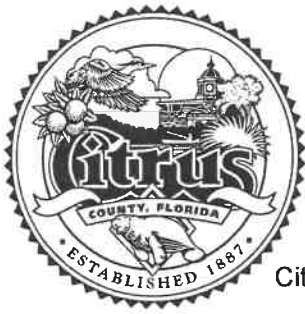

Pursuant to Section L. 10 of the Emergency Incidents and Contingency Plan, this report contains information regarding the fire that occurred within our facility on January 2, 2021. The Citrus County Fire Department was dispatched at 6:55 pm. Division of Solid Waste Management emergency contacts were called pursuant to our Operation and Contingency Plans and staff arrived at the facility between 8:00 and 8:10 pm. The fire was confined to the Northeast portion of Phase 3 in the working face. 50,000 gallons of water were used to extinguish and contain the fire. Containment of the fire was done by 8:22 pm. Immediately after, the waste was covered with 4 loads of soil. It is apparent that no damage to the cell's liners occurred, nor did any damage occur to the operational systems for gas and leachate collection systems, or storm water conveyance system.
