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## **EXTERNAL MESSAGE**

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Pursuant to Condition 4 of the Water Quality Monitoring Plan associated with the site permit, Trail Ridge Landfill, Inc (TRL) hereby notifies the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (the Department) of first-time parameter detections above the Department's water quality standards (exceedance) specified in Chapter 62-520, F.A.C.

An initial detection of the following parameters above the Department's water quality standard were observed during the February 2022 monitoring event:

- Benzene and chloride at monitoring well MWB-39S
- Arsenic at monitoring well MWB-12S
- Chromium at monitoring well MWB-13S
- Iron at monitoring well MWB-11I(R)

These monitoring locations will be re-sampled on March 24 to confirm the detections. Other constituents above the Department's water quality standards or criteria specified in Chapter 62-520, F.A.C., in monitoring wells at Trail Ridge Landfill have been previously reported and will be discussed in the forthcoming semiannual report of the February 2022 data.

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
