On behalf of the Citrus County Solid Waste Management Department, Jones Edmunds is pleased to provide this permit application to construct and operate the Class I Landfill Phase 4 Expansion at the Citrus County Central Landfill in Lecanto, Florida.

Please find Application Form 62-701.900(1) and the accompanying engineering report, engineering plans, and supporting documentation for the proposed construction and operation of the facility. We have submitted this application in electronic portable document format (PDF) and the appropriate sections have been digitally signed and sealed in accordance with the requirements of the Florida Board of Professional Engineers.

The Phase 4 Expansion is on property owned by Citrus County and surrounded by property leased to the County by the Florida Division of Forestry. The proposed Phase 4 Expansion area has the same distance of horizontal separation between the nearest property boundary to the east and its edge of liner as the previous landfill cells. This distance is less than 100 feet; however, Phase 4 is positioned in line with the previous cells (Phases 1 through 3). Please let us know if you would like to discuss this further.


This permit application proposes a substantial modification to construct the Phase 4 Expansion and an intermediate permit modification to the facility's Operation Permit. A check in the amount of \$15,000 will be mailed to you for the permit fees associated with the substantial modification and intermediate permit modification.

The current operations permit is a 10-year permit and will expire August 15, 2026.
