Pursuant to Section 403.815, Florida Statutes and DEP Rule 62-110.106, Florida Administrative Code, you are required to publish at your own expense the enclosed Notice of Application. The notice shall be published one time only within fourteen days, in the legal ad section of a newspaper of general circulation in the area affected. For the purpose of this rule, "publication in a newspaper of general circulation in the area affected" means publication in a newspaper meeting the requirements of Sections 50.011 and 50.031, Florida Statutes, in the county where the activity is to take place. Where there is more than one newspaper of general circulation in the county, the newspaper used must be one with significant circulation in the area that may be affected by the permit. If you are uncertain that a newspaper meets these requirements, please contact the undersigned at the address and telephone number listed below.

The applicant shall provide proof of publication to the Department, at 2600 Blair Stone Road, Mail Station 4565, Tallahassee, Florida, 32399, within seven days of publication. Failure to publish the notice and provide proof of publication within the allotted time may result in the denial of the permit.
